The motto of National Sanskrit University “Tamaso ma Jyotirgamaya” speaks of the vision and idealism for which the Vidyapeetha (NSU) was established.

1. Academic -

The NSU has achieved a rare honour of being recognised as a Centre of Excellence in Traditional Sastras by the UGC basing on its achievements, academic excellence earned in the field of teaching and research in Traditional Shastras and its potential for future development.

Well versed qualified teachers teach the Traditional Shastras and Professional subjects through Sanskrit medium with the help of ICT.

The learning objectives are clearly spelt out for all the undergraduate and postgraduate programs and the student manual contains information on the teaching, learning and assessment activities for the entire academic year. The University has incorporated a variety of teaching and learning methods depending on the course. These include, in addition to didactic lectures, interactive sessions, small group discussions, student seminars, interdepartmental discussions (वाक्यार्थः) as well as presentations and demonstrations. The laboratories for ICT & Psychology practical sessions are adequate and well-maintained.

National Sanskrit University has added several computer-assisted learning facilities in the campus. Computers with Internet facilities have been added in all faculties and departments in addition to establishing Active Learning Centres in the Shastra courses & Professional courses. The curriculum is regularly reviewed and revised every 3 years and revision takes place from workshops and other academic inputs. Many National Award-winning teachers are here, after studying from this university a lot of people are working in higher positions, data of all those people has been collected. From this we come to know that the learning performance of the students is very high and we can see the learning outcomes from it as well.

Our faculty members have published a good number of books, articles and research papers, as well as continued participation in refresher orientation and other faculty development programs. Newly established the independent department of Sangeetha Shastra (Performing Arts).

2. Administrative –

IT infrastructure - The University established one more ICT lab in the department of education, where students are using all 46 computers for learning. University website is dynamic & informatic. We installed solar panels for saving energy. Prathibham is a one of the small open auditoriums constructed in-front of Education building for performing arts, cultural programs & multi activities. Purchased one more large size generator for backup purposes. Newly constructed five floor classroom complex, boy's hostel & seminar halls. Renewed health centre was appointed two doctors, Nursing officers & Laboratory assistant. University recruited 70 teaching & non-teaching staffs.

Our University has two such excellent libraries, one is in the Department of Education and the other is Mahamahopadhyaya Sri PattabhiramaSastri Central Library, which is one of the most famous Sanskrit libraries in India which contains more than one lakh valuable books. Many rare old Sanskrit books and manuscripts of Sanskrit and Prakrit are also available in our library.

Owing to its past records, academic achievements and capabilities of the University, the Government of India upgraded deemed University to the status of a Central University in the year of 2020.
