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## **ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY**

Located at the sacred foot of Tirumala Hills, National Sanskrit University has been the destination for students and scholars seeking Sanskrit education for the past six decades. A veritable miniature India, the University has been drawing students from all corners of our nation, belonging to different regions, languages, and creeds, as it has been providing ideal facilities and conducive atmosphere for study and research. Further, innovative, and interdisciplinary courses and state-of-the-art computer facilities have made it a much sought-after institution for Sanskrit studies. Conveniently located in the centre of Tirupati town, the campus is very attractive with tall shady trees and well nurtured gardens.

On the recommendations of the Central Sanskrit Commission appointed by the Government of India during 1950s, a Central Sanskrit Institute was established at Tirupati in 1961 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India for the preservation and propagation of traditional Sanskrit learning combining it with the modern methods of research. The Government of India constituted an autonomous registered body called 'Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha Tirupati Society' for the administration of the Institution. The foundation stone for the Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha was laid by the then Vice-President of India, Dr.S.Radhakrishnan on 4th January 1962. About forty-two acres of land was leased out by the prestigious Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams Trust Board, headed by the then Executive Officer, Dr.C.Anna Rao, along with a munificent donation of Rs.10 lakh towards construction of buildings.

The Vidyapeetha Society has had a galaxy of reputed scholars and statesmen as its successive Chairmen, viz. Sri Patanjali Sastry, former Chief Justice of India being the first, followed by Prof.V.Raghavan, a reputed Indologist and Sri M.Ananthasayanam Iyengar, former Speaker of Lok Sabha. Dr. B.R. Sharma was the first Director of the Institute from 1962 to 1970. Sri Venkata Raghavacharya, Dr.Mandan Mishra, Dr.R.Karunakaran, Dr. M.D. Balasubramanyam and Prof. N.S. Ramanuja Tatacharya served the institution in the capacity of Principal and contributed their scholastic and administrative experience to a large extent.

Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha came under the aegis of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan – an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education in April, 1971. During the Silver Jubilee celebrations in 1987, Sri P.V.Narasimha Rao, the then Union Minister of Human Resource Development, Government of India, declared the Vidyapeetha as a Deemed-to-be-University on the recommendations of the University Grants Commission under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956. (vide Gazette notification No.F.9-2/85 U-3 dated 16-11-1987). The Deemed-to-be-University was formally inaugurated by the then President of India Sri R.Venkataraman on 26th August 1989. The University started functioning as a Deemed-to-be-University in the name of Rastriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha from the Academic Year 1991-92. The Vidyapeetha has been upgraded as the Central University in the name of National

Sanskrit University with the enactment by the Parliament of the Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 in April 2020.

In its illustrious journey, eminent personalities Mahamahopadhyaya Sri Pattabhirama Sastri, Prof. Ramaranjan Mukherjee and Dr. V.R.Panchamukhi were the Chancellors. Sri N. Gopalaswami, recipient of Padma Bhushan and former Chief Election Commissioner of India was appointed as the Chancellor of the University on 21<sup>st</sup> October 2015, and he continues to head the University during the year under report.

Prof.N.S.Ramanuja Tatacharya, Prof.S.B. Raghunathacharya and Prof. D. Prahlada Char served the University as Vice-Chancellors. Prof. K.E. Govindan served as the Vice-Chancellor i/c. for two years up to April 2006. Prof. Hare Krishna Satapathy served as the Vice-Chancellor from 2006 to 2016. Prof. S.S. Murthy and Prof. M L N Murthy held charge as in-charge Vice Chancellors from 2016 to 2017. Prof. V. Muralidhara Sharma 15.01.2017 and served the University as its Vice-Chancellor during the period from 15.01.2017 to 13.01.2022. Prof. Radhakant Thakur was the In-charge Vice-Chancellor from 15.01.2022 to 05.08.2023. Prof. E. Suresh Kumar, the Vice-Chancellor, English and Foreign Languages University, Hyderabad held additional charge of the post of the Vice-Chancellor of this University for a short stint from 06.08.2022 to 09.09.2022. Prof. G.S.R. Krishna Murty, Professor and Dean, School of Sahitya & Samskriti was appointed as the regular Vice-Chancellor of the University, and he took over on 09.09.2022. Commander Challa Venkateswar (Retired) continued to be the REgistrar of the University during the year.

The University has a total sanctioned strength of 214 (teaching: 109 and Non-teaching: 105). During the year, 2001 students took admission into various courses. The Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams, Tirupati leased additional land of Ac. 13.60 cents during the year and the University took possession of the land in May 2022.

**INTRODUCTION**

National Sanskrit University, Central University is a premier institution in the field of higher learning in Sanskrit studies, Traditional Sastras and Sanskrit Teacher Education. It is funded by the Ministry of Education through UGC. The University has a long history in the service of Sanskrit education.

The University was established at Tirupati (A.P.) in 1961 by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the Sanskrit Commission (1957) as an autonomous body under the name

of **Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati Society**. Dr. S. Radhakrishnan, the then Vice President of India laid the foundation stone of the Vidyapeetha on 4th January 1962. The basic objective of setting up the Vidyapeetha is to impart and improve Sanskrit Teacher Education, to accelerate the pace of higher Sanskrit learning and to combine the traditional Sanskrit education with modern scientific research.

Later, Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati came under the administrative control of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education in April 1971. **In the year 1987, the Vidyapeetha was declared as a Deemed-to-be-University by Government of India**, considering its service to the cause of Sanskrit Education, its achievements in research and publications and the general progress it had made. It was formally inaugurated by the then President of India Sri R. Venkatraman on 26th of August 1989. Considering its achievements and potential for research in Traditional Sastras, the University was given the status of **Centre of Excellence in Traditional Sastras** during the X, XI and XII Plans.

Considering the achievements of the Vidyapeetha in the field of Sanskrit and Traditional Sastras, the Vidyapeetha is elevated as **National Sanskrit University** (Central University) by Govt. of India by an act of Parliament in the month of March 2020 and university is now functioning as National Sanskrit University from 30th April 2020.

#### **Location**

The University has a sprawling campus of 41 acres and is located at the foot of the Tirumala Hills, the abode of Lord Sri Venkateswara (Balaji) near Alipiri. The University campus, adjacent to SVIMS (Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences), is at 4 kms from Railway Station and APSRTC Bus Station. It can be approached through Reservoir Road and Balaji Colony.

#### **Emblem**

The motto on the emblem *Tamaso ma Jyotirgamaya* speaks of the vision and idealism for which the University was established. The emblem comprises a circle, a rectangular base, two lamps on side, a bunch of palm leaves, the petals of a lotus, each of which are of immense significance. Besides, it includes the rays of the Sun which are considered to represent a perennial source of creative thoughts.

#### **Infrastructure:**

1. **Administrative Building:** The University has two storeyed building for administrative needs.
2. **Academic Buildings:** A separate building with two connected blocks is being utilized only for teaching and research. It is named after a renowned scholar; the first Vice-Chancellor of University *Padmabushan Mahamahopadhyaya Navalpakkam Satakopa Ramanuja Tatacharya*. The building also houses a

Seminar Hall. The new Academic Building named after Dr. Chelikani Anna Rao constructed with the funding from HEFA has been made operational during the year.

3. **Library Building:** The library is accommodated in a spacious two storeyed building with the special arrangements for preservation of manuscripts.
4. **Education Building:** The School of Education is functioning in an independent two storeyed building.
5. **Transit Hostel/Guest House:** The University has two-storeyed transit hostel/guest house.
6. **Hostels:** The University houses on its campus nine hostels. Five for boys, three for girls and one for research scholars.
7. **Staff Quarters:** The University has limited quarters for its teaching and non-teaching staff.
8. **Ashrama Type Study Centers:** The University has Ashrama Type Study Centers in the names of great sages and Acharyas built under Shastra Varidhi programme.
9. **Playground:** The playground takes care of all outdoor sports and games activities with eight lanes 400 Mt. running track.
10. **Indoor Stadium:** An Indoor-Stadium has been established with all facilities for Indoor games such as Badminton, Table Tennis, Chess, Carroms.
11. **Multi Gym:** A Multi Gym has been established for the benefit of students, A Gym for girls has also been established in women's hostel.
12. **Sansk-Net Centre:** A Sansk-Net Centre has been functioning in the Campus.
13. **E-Class room:** E-Class room is a novel concept that caters to the needs of the students as e-Learning is slowly occupying a significant role in the field of education. In view of the latest developments, the University has adopted and introduced Computer Assisted Instruction in the E-Class room.
14. **Advanced Computer Centre:** Advanced Computer Centre has been established for e- learning requirements.
15. **ICT Resource Centre:** The University established "Information and Communication Technology Resource Centre" with 60 Computer systems in the Academic Building.
16. **Model Career Centre:** This centre at the University has been established under the aegis of National Career Service Project of the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. of India, to provide a variety of Government related services to the youth.
17. **Computer Lab for MAIMT:** A computer lab has been established for Masters in Ancient Indian Management Techniques (MAIMT) students.



18. **Prof. SBR Open Air Auditorium:** To commemorate the services of former Vice-Chancellor Late Prof. S.B. Raghunathacharya the Open-Air Auditorium has been named as “Prof. SBR Open-Air Auditorium” wherein various academic and cultural programmes of the University are conducted.
19. **Ramaranjan Mukherjee Auditorium:** This auditorium is being used to conduct seminars, workshops etc.
20. **Alternative power system:** Keeping in view the frequent Power fluctuations/break downs, University has established an alternative power system (Diesel generator) with 160 KVA with 200 litre tank capacity of Kirloskar make. This facilitates an uninterrupted power supply to the entire University.
21. **Utilization of Solar Power in the University campus:** The University through CPWD (E) made Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Hero Solar Energy Pvt. Ltd. which is a Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) approved bidder for 156 KW Rooftop Solar PV (Photovoltaic) Panels to utilize maximum Green Energy in the campus.
22. **Bank:** A branch of Union Bank of India (R S Vidyapeetha Branch) is functioning in the University. ATM was also established for the benefit of students & staff members.
23. **Post Office:** A Post Office has been functioning on the campus.
24. **University Health Centre:** -The University Health Centre has been established to provide primary and emergency medical services to students, research scholars, teaching and non-teaching staff, and authorized dependents of the teaching and non-teaching staff.
25. **"Sujalam"** Safe Drinking Water through RO System has provided in the campus.
26. **Parents' retiring room facility:** The University provides accommodation facility in the University campus to the parents/guardians of the students visiting the University campus either at the time of admission or during their visits on any other occasion.
27. **Women's Facility Centre:** As per the guidelines of the UGC, the University has established one Common Facilities Centre providing various facilities for the women staff and students of the University.
28. **Academic Programmes offered:**  
 In accordance with National Education Policy (NEP) -2020, the UG Programmes of NSU are designed **with multiple exits** at the end of I Year, II-year, III year and IV year.
  - a) **Regular programmes:** -Prak-Sastri; Sastri (B.A.); B.A.; B.Sc. Comp.; B.Sc. in Yoga; Acharya (M.A.); MA in Hindi ; M.Sc. in Computer Science & Language Technology, M.Sc. in Yoga Therapy.
  - b) **Professional Programmes:** Siksha Sastri (B.Ed.) & Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.)
  - c) **Research Programmes:** Ph.D. (Vidyavaridhi); D.Litt. (Vidyavachaspati)

- d) **Online Programmes:** Short term online courses in 27 subjects have been conducted.
- e) **Diploma and Certificate Courses:** Diploma in Temple Culture; Pourohitya; Yoga Vijnana, Sanskrit and Law, Management. Certificate course in Temple Culture, Pourohitya, Functional English and Jyotisha.
- f) **Distance Education:** Prak-Sastri, Sastri (B.A.), Acharya (M.A.), Certificate in Sanskrit, Diploma in Sanskrit and P.G. Diploma in Yoga Vijnana.
- g) **Innovative Programme:** The University has been running MAIMT (Master in Ancient Indian Management Techniques) - (Two years) under the Innovative programme.
- h) **Bridge Course:** The Bridge course is run at the beginning of the Academic Year which is meant for improving the quality of learning for new entrants of the University.

### **Projects:**

#### **(i) Orissa Chair:**

The Government of Orissa has established the Orissa Chair in the University with the seed grant of Rs 50 lakhs to do intensive research, to bring out publications on Lord Sri Jagannatha and to highlight the contributions made by Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu and poet Sri Jayadeva to the cultural heritage of our country. The Chair was formally inaugurated by Justice Sri Ranganath Mishra, Former Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of India and Chairman, Central Sanskrit Board, Govt of India on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2000.

#### **(ii) Shri Ramanuja Project:**

Shri Ramanujacharya Project is one of the prestigious projects with an amount of Rs. 118.33 lakhs funded by the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, New Delhi to Digitize, Edit and publish the manuscripts related to Saint Shri Ramanujacharya on the 1000<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of Shri Ramanujacharya.

#### **(iii) Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNTT) (SBN):**

The Project is funded by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objectives of the Project are to address shortcomings related to teachers and teaching.

To meet shortage of teachers: Create and strengthen the institutional mechanisms, improve quality of teaching, and empower teachers and faculty through training, re-training; Refresher and orientation programmes; Create a sufficient base of teacher educators; Prepare faculty for academic leadership positions; Capacity building for curriculum development and teaching and learning material.



**(iv) Mahabharata Telugu Translation Project:**

To bring out Sloka-wise Telugu Translation for the entire VYASAMAHABHARATA

**Objectives of the Project**

- 1.To Prepare Electronic Text with Hyperlinks;
- 2.To Prepare text for Print Mode; and
- 3.To prepare a website hosting both the Moola Sanskrit slokas and Telugu Translations

An amount of Rs.70 lakh has been sanctioned to this Project. The project is currently under progress and almost 2/3rd of the slokas of **VYASAMAHABHARATA** have been translated into Telugu. DTP and Proof-reading works are also progressing at a swift pace.

**(v) Ashtadashi: Nyayapradipa - Multi-lingual Nyaya philosophy e-corpus**

**Objectives of the Project**

- I To create a dedicated e-repository for Nyaya philosophy;
- II. To facilitate perusal of Nyaya texts in multiple Indian languages; and
- III. To empower researchers world-wide by providing a one-stop website for Nyaya works

An amount of Rs.12.40 lakh ( Rupees Twelve Lakh Forty Thousand ) has been sanctioned to Dr. OGP Kalyana Sastry for the Nyayapradipa project. Phase- I of the project is currently underway.

**vi)** The Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi also sanctioned two Ashtadashi projects, during the year 2022-23, one to Prof. Narayan and another Dr. S. Vyshnavi & Dr. K. Sujani.

## **ABOUT DEPARTMENTS**

### **Information and Communication Technology Resource Centre (ICTRC)**

The Information and Communication Technology Resource Center (ICTRC) was started with 60 computer systems in the Academic Building with the main objective of catering the ICT needs of the Academic and administrative wings of the University.

- Facilitated in organizing four workshops for various Departments for faculty and students of the University.
- The computational resources were made available for faculty and students for working on various SWAYAM, MOOCS and NMEICT (Machine Hours utilized: 2000 Hrs.).
- Working together with Administration for implementation of SAMARTH Project, PFMS online payment system by installing necessary software and configuration settings in National Sanskrit University.
- Maintaining the University Website and Network/LAN Management.
- Playing a vital role in supporting the teaching and non-teaching staff in terms of software and hardware management for all the computers, laptops, printers, and projects of the University.
- Providing technical assistance and organising the LIVE (Youtube/Facebook) for the NSU programs as per the requirements of the University. In the last academic year 63 programs were given technical assistance.
- Playing a vital role in the implementation of NAD/Digilocker as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

### **Cyber Security and CCMP**

- Proposed NSU CCMP (Cyber Security Management Plan) guidelines by organizing orientation for ICTRC staff with the CERT empanelled agencies. CISO along with ICTRC team participated in orientation on 07.02.2023, 09.02.2023 & 14.02.2023.

### **ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLANNING (ERP)**

As part of the initiative to develop a paperless office, an Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) system was introduced. The full-fledged ERP Cell was established on the 1st floor of the Sansknet Building. The University identified and adopted the SAMARTH eGov suite, which is an initiative of Ministry of Education, Govt. of Indi, as the ERP solution. The Samarth has 9 core modules and 40+ sub modules to facilitate the functioning of the University system. During the year 2022-23 the following Samarth modules are implemented:

1. **Health Management System Module:** Health Management is the overall management of a healthcare facility for the campus. The University created health records of all the employees and their dependents.

2. **Admission Management Module:** For the academic year 2022-23, the University developed the admission module and the students for the following streams have been admitted through this module and the admission fee is collected through this admission module only.

1. Prak-Shastri, 2. Sastri based on CUET, 3. Shastri (Non-CUET), 4. Acharya all courses (CUET), 5. Acharya all courses (Non-CUET), 6. Siksha Shastri (B.Ed) through CUET, 7. Siksha Acharya through CUET and 8. All Evening programmes.

3. **Academic Management Module:** From Academic year 2022-23, The University as adopted the academic module.

i) Programme module: In this module, the University has created all the programmes and elective courses were uploaded in the module.

ii) Students: This module is to keep track of students present under different programmes in the University. From this academic session 2022-23, dash boards and unique student logins have been provided and Examination fee is also collected through this Module.

iii) Examination: For the following programmes, hall tickets were successfully issued through this module to the students of 1. Prak-Shastri, 2. Under Graduation (UG), 3. Post Graduation (PG), 4. Siksha Shastri (B.Ed.), 5. Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.).

4. **Inventory Management Module:** This Module is implemented from 2022-23 to account for the consumable and non-consumable inventories and their issue to the indentors.

## **DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE:**

The Department of Computer Science was established in the year 1996. The main objectives of the Department of Computer Science are to:

- ▶ impart IT and Computer Applications skills to the students of various Sastras, enabling them to be on par with the latest computer technologies, tools and resources etc., available in Sanskrit research areas;
- ▶ apply Information Technologies for Sanskrit Traditional courses taught by the University;
- ▶ apply Sanskrit Traditional Knowledge Theories for developing Intelligent Computer Applications for Sanskrit; and
- ▶ build bridge between Sanskrit and Information and Technologies

The Dept. of Computer Science is striving hard to meet the computing needs of the University students. The Department is running the following courses:

- ▶ Twelve papers of Computer Application in Sastri
- ▶ Four papers of Computer Science in B.Sc.
- ▶ Twenty papers of M.Sc (Computer Science and Sanskrit Language Technology)
- ▶ Eight papers of M.A. in Sanskrit (Sabdabodha & Sanskrit Language Technology)

The Department has a total workload of 26 theory and 20 labs. At present, the Department has five teaching faculty, one guest faculty and one Technical Assistant. 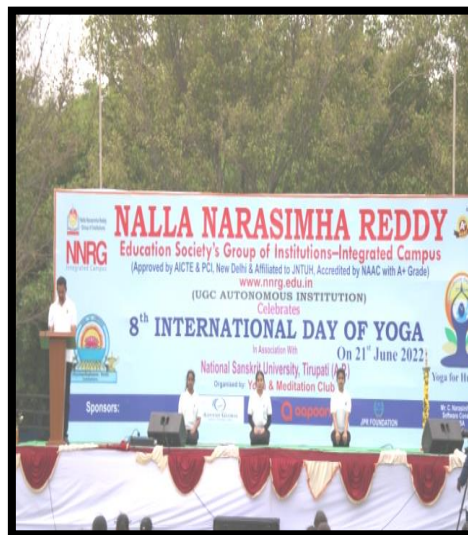
## Valedictory

**ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR REGULAR PROGRAMMES**

The Academic Year 2022-23 began in the month of July 2022 and concluded in May 2023 with the conduct of examinations. The semester pattern is being followed in all UG and PG Programmes. Admissions into Prak-Shastri programme are made on the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination and personal interview and Shastri / BA programmes, B.Sc. Computers, B.Sc. in Yoga, Acharya, M.A. in Sabdabodha, M.A. in Hindi, M.Sc. in Yoga Therapy, M.Sc. in Computers, MAIMT, Siksha Sastri (B.Ed.), Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.) programmes are made on the basis of marks secured in the CUET conducted by NTA at National level and personal interview. Admissions into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) are based on the entrance test conducted by the University at the national level. Holders of NET/SLET/M.Phil are exempted from appearance in the entrance test for Vidyavaridhi. Scholars can pursue research on a full time or part-time basis. The admission notifications for all the programmes are placed on the University **website:** <http://www.nsktu.ac.in>. Shastras in all programmes are taught in Sanskrit medium only and the examination is conducted in Sanskrit. For modern subjects, the medium of instruction and examination is English and for other languages the respective language is the medium of instruction and examination.

**Merit Scholarships**

Merit Scholarships are awarded to students based on the percentage of marks/merit obtained in the last qualifying examination. Students of Prak-Sastri I year, II year, Sastri I, II & III year, and students of each sastra in Acharya I and II year are given Merit Scholarships.

### Implementation of Reservation Policy

This is also implemented in admission of the students to various courses viz. Prak-Sastri, Sastri, Acharya, SikshaSastri (B.Ed.), Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.) and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.).

The Department of Education provides a pre-service programme in Sanskrit for preparing teachers for secondary school. ### (c) Non-formal Education

Education is a continuous process and is not constrained / restricted to age. The system of Distance Education has emerged as an alternative to accommodate the growing needs of education in the present modern world. The Distance education system fulfils the needs of all those who could not pursue a normal formal college education system



(or) who could not complete their studies due to financial problems/others (or) to those who would like to improve their knowledge.

In order to enrich the hidden treasure of Sanskrit and to protect the importance and usefulness of Sanskrit language and Literature, a proposal of the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati to start the Directorate of Distance Education was approved by the Distance Education Council (DEC) and thus the Directorate of Distance Education was established in the year 2003 with the financial support from Distance Education Council (DEC)/ Distance Education Bureau (DEB)/University Grants Commission (UGC) for preparation of course materials and for students support ever since it has been actually functioning under the aegis of DEC / DEB / UGC.

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati, has been declared as **National Sanskrit University, Tirupati** under the Act of Parliament during the year 2020. Subsequently, as per the University Grants commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 [Sl.No.8(3)] the Directorate of Distance Education has been renamed as **Center of Distance and Online Education** from 29.03.2021 and included all the Online Programmes.

Prof. K.S. Sateesha, Department of Advaita Vedanta is the Director of IQAC. The IQAC cell is assisting and guiding the University in the development of Assessment Criteria and Methodology, Proforma based on these regulations.

### **Maxmuller English Club:**

Maxmuller English Club was established to improve communication skills of students in English. The activities of the club are run by the students themselves under the guidance of the coordinators of the club and faculty of the Department of English Prof. R. Deepta and Dr. BLVG Jagan Mohan. Every Saturday the club meets to have a competition or an activity. The entire session is run by the students themselves. Each time a different set of students is selected to organise the session. A faculty member is usually invited to be the judge for the competition. Prizes are given at Praksastri, Sastri and Acharya levels. The prizes are distributed at the Valedictory Function usually held at the end of the academic year.

For the academic year 2022-23, Maxmuller English Club was inaugurated for the Academic year 2022-23 on 1st November 2022 by the then Dean Academic Affairs, National Sanskrit University Prof. G. S. R. Krishna Murty. In all, 7 sessions were organised in the odd semester of the Academic year and 7 sessions in the even semester of the Academic year.

The first session was held on 10<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The competition held was Writing Skills - Essay Writing. The topics given were 'The Role of the Teacher in Student's life' for Sastri and Acharya levels and "My College" for Prak-Sastri level. In all, 76 students participated in the event. Prof. R. Deepta was the Judge.

The second session was held on 17<sup>th</sup> September 2022. The election was the competition held for Praksastri level. For Sastri and Acharya level it was 'Role Play'. 35 students participated in the session. Dr. BLVG Jagan Mohan was the judge.

The third session was held on 24<sup>th</sup> September 2022, 'Pick and speak' was conducted for PrakSastri students and Elocution competition on "Social Media – Use and Abuse" was conducted for Sastri and Acharya levels. 24 students participated in the competition. Dr. G. Ranga Rao was the judge.

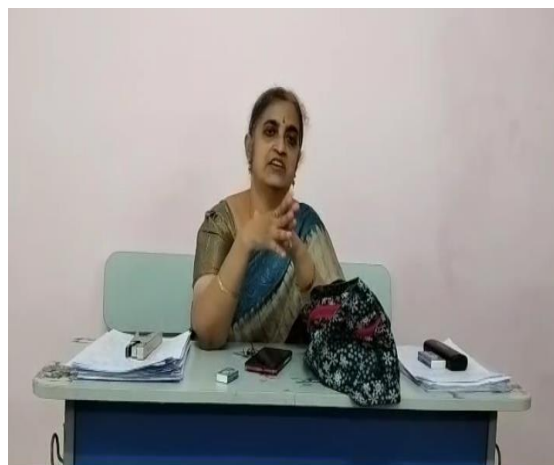

### **Annamacharya Sahitya Kalaparishad**

It offers scope for students to enrich their literary knowledge and improve their language skills in Telugu. Annamacharya Sahitya Kalaparishad is the Telugu literary and cultural organization in the University. This Parishad is run by the students under the guidance of Telugu Department faculty. It started in the year 2011. This Parishad conducts training programmes in performing arts, organizes elocution, essay writing, quiz, poetry recitation and cultural events, thus bringing out the hidden talents of the students in Telugu Language, Literature and culture. This Parishad specially organizes competitions for non-Telugu students who join the University from different parts of India.

### **Sanskritika Kalaparishad**

Sanskritasaptaha/ Navaratnam is a special program, in which many cultural and literary competitions are conducted every year in the month of August, for teachers and students. The Performing Arts Department of the University offers Dance, Music, vocal and instrument certificate, diploma, programmes in addition to regular programmes. Many cultural programmes have been conducted during the year.

## **Sports & Games**

The University has its own Department of Physical Education for providing regular training to the students in Sports and Games throughout the year. The University has spacious and well-equipped Indoor Stadium with wooden flooring catering to the needs of the students in groups. Another significant feature is the multi-station gymnasium with 16 pieces of equipment. In addition, the latest and modern equipment such as Treadmill, Abdomen Machine, Leg Vibrator Machine, Cycling Machine etc. are also available to the students. The womens' hostel is also equipped with a separate gymnasium, exclusively for women students. These facilities enable students to improve their physical fitness and overall development. The University has a playground with eight lanes 400 mt running track with two galleries and provision for playing Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Ball – Badminton, Kabaddi, Kho - Kho etc., and for conducting sports tournaments. The students at the University having interest in their respective sports fields have been encouraged to take participation in All India and South Zone Inter-University competitions held in sports and games conducted by AIU.

### **PROMOTION OF ENVIRONMENT FRIENDLY CAMPUS BICYCLES**

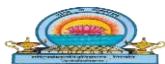

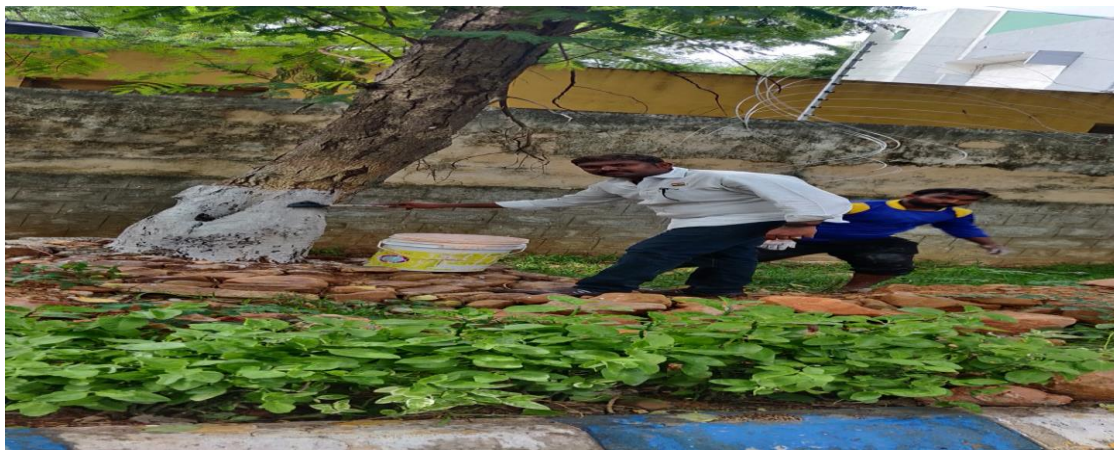


### **76<sup>th</sup> Independence Day Celebrations- 15-8-2022**

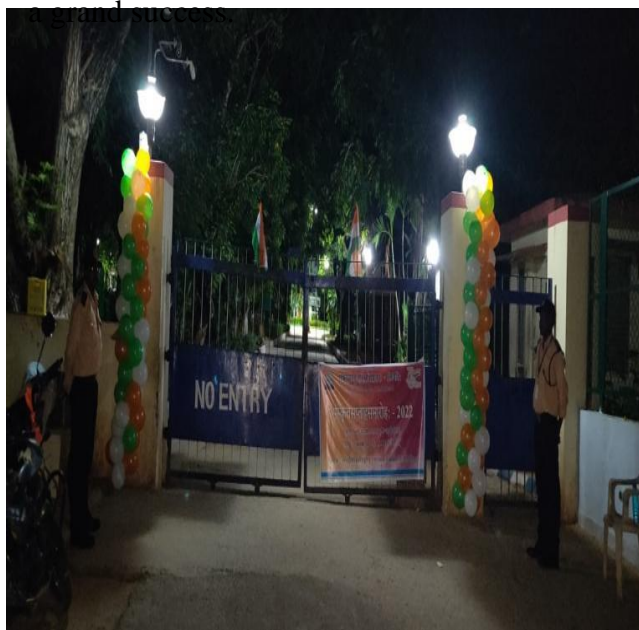

## **VI. PROJECTS**

### **A. Orissa Chair**

The Government of Odisha established the Odisha Chair in National Sanskrit University, Tirupati. A seed grant of Rs 50 lakh was sanctioned to do intensive research, to bring out publications on Lord Sri Jagannath and to highlight the contributions made by Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu and the poet Sri Jayadeva to the cultural heritage of our country. The Chair was formally inaugurated by justice Sri Ranganath Mishra, Former Chief Justice of the Supreme court of India and Chairman, Central Sanskrit Board, Govt. of India on 14<sup>th</sup> October 2000.

#### **Odisha Chair activities are as follows:**

1. Utkal Divas was observed by the Odisha Chair on 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2022 through Online . In this connection Odisha Chair organised a Special talk about Odishan Culture collaboration and Utkal Parisad, Tirupati. Hon'ble M.P. and former Central minister of India Sri. Pratap Chandra Sarangi as Chief Guest, Prof. Harekrushna Satapathy former V.C. ## **B. SHRI RAMANUJACHARYA PROJECT**

Shri Ramanujacharya Project is one of the prestigious projects funded by the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, New Delhi to Digitize, Edit and publish the manuscripts related to Saint Shri Ramanujacharya on the Occasion of the 1000<sup>th</sup> Birth Anniversary of the Shri Ramanujacharya, with an amount of Rs.118.33 lakhs.

## **C. Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNTT)**

The Project is funded by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objectives of the Project are to address the shortcomings related to teachers and teaching:

To Meet shortage of teachers, create and strengthen the institutional mechanisms, improve quality of teaching and empower teachers and faculty through training, re-training, refresher and orientation programmes, create a sufficient base of teacher educators, Prepare faculty for academic leadership positions, Capacity building for curriculum development, assessment, and teaching and learning material.

### **Sanskruta Vikasa Kendra:**

It started with the noble cause of University's engagement with society. Under Balakendram, spoken Sanskrit Sibirams were organized.

### **Centre for Sanskrit Language Promotion:**

Acharya V. Muralidhar Sharma, Vice-Chancellor, National Sanskrit University, Tirupati inaugurated the Centre for Sanskrit Language Promotion from this centre, all citizens and children are taught Sanskrit language and ideas related to our culture.

The main functions of the Centre for Sanskrit Language Promotion are as follows:

- Planning children's Classes [Balakendram].
- Online Sanskrit Classes [Balagokulam].
- Organizing Spoken Sanskrit camps.
- Performance of festivals like Gita Jayanti.
- Develop the language skills of new entrants.
- Discharge of the follow-up class.
- Special Lectures.

## **VII. INFRASTRUCTURE & FACILITIES**

### **A. Central Library**

The National Sanskrit University Library is named after Mahamahopadhyaya Sri Pattabhirama Sastri. The library has the largest collection of learning resources on Sanskrit studies, Traditional Sastras, and Pedagogy. The library supports the research and educational endeavours of students, research scholars, and the faculties of the university by collecting, organizing, preserving, and disseminating information and providing instructional programs in all formats through need-based services and enabling access to online information resources using modern information and communication technologies.

The University Library is automated with an open-source integrated library system (ILS) (KOHA-20.04). The library is using Colon Classification (CC) system to organize the knowledge collection. The library has a good collection of documents on all subjects and the total collection of books is around 1,28,950 and 136 periodicals. The library has more than 4007 bundles of manuscripts in different languages like Sanskrit, Telugu, Tamil, and different scripts such as Devanagari, Grantha, Telugu, Kannada, Tigalari etc. The library has introduced the DSpace an Open-Source Software package that provides the tools for management of digital assets and is commonly used as the basis for an institutional repository.

The Library became a member of INFLIBNET by which it would be providing information and reference data about Sanskrit through networking and about national and international Sanskrit scholars.

### **B. Guest House, Hostels & Messes**

#### **(i) Guest House**

The University Guest House consists of Ground +2 floors. There are a total of 19 rooms with 12 two-bedded rooms, 05 three-bedded rooms and two Suite rooms. A dining hall with a kitchen is also available in the Ground Floor. These rooms are mainly meant for guests from MoE, UGC etc. who visit University on official purposes. Based on availability, rooms are allotted to staff guests. Seven dining tables have been added to the dining hall to augment the dining hall capacity to 36 and further, a new refrigerator is purchased and installed.

#### **(ii) Boys Hostel**

The University has been maintaining 5 hostels for men students, viz. Garudachala, Neelachala, Vedachala, Seshachala and Venkatachala. The following are the salient features:

- The newly constructed 501 capacity Venkatachala hostel has been opened with fully furnished cots, chairs, tables, water coolers etc.
- Five New Televisions with Dish connection were provided for recreation facility.



- Purchased 170 new cots and provided at Neelachala (118) and Seshachala(52) hostels.
- 309 Chairs had been provided to Garudachala (98), Neelachala (98), Vedachala (77) and Seshachala (36).
- Four water coolers had been provided.
- Executive table, chair and visitor chairs had been provided to wardens in their hostels.
- Executive table, chair and visitor chairs had been provided to Chief Warden's Office at the Venkatachala Hostel.

### **(iii) Ladies hostel**

The University has 4 separate hostels, Viz. Padmachala, Vidyachala, Vakulachala and Simhachala for women students in addition to one dormitory.

- Simhachala Hostel: This year Simhachala hostel has been converted to Ladies hostel for the convenience of the lady students and it was allotted to Siksha Sastri and Vidyavaridhi scholars.
- Two New Televisions with Dish connection were provided for recreation facility.
- Purchased 169 new cots and provided to Simhachala (63) and Vakulachala (106) hostels.
- 143 Chairs provided to Padmachala (57), Vidyachala (5), Vakulachala (33) and Dormitory (48).
- Four water coolers had been provided.
- Executive table, chair and visitor chairs had been provided to wardens in their hostels.
- Six Sanitary Napkin Vending machines and Incinerators have been installed, on trial basis, at the Simhachala Hostel which has since been allotted to ladies.

### **(iv) Messes**

- Venkatachala Mess was opened in this academic year with G+1 floor and it consists of 04 dining halls with one attached kitchen.
- Roti Machines: This year 02 new roti machines have been purchased and installed. These are installed at Padmavathi Mess and utilized for both Padmavathi mess and Venkatachala mess.
- Six new water coolers have been installed in Venkatachala (4), Padmavathi (1) and Srinivasa (1) mess.
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### **C. Psychology Laboratory**

To facilitate training for students of Education in a scientific manner the Psychology laboratory of National Sanskrit University was established in the Department of Education. The Laboratory is well equipped with Computers, Projectors and Furniture. It has been serving a useful purpose for B.Ed. and M.Ed. students in building their mental and cognitive abilities.

#### **D. Language Laboratory**

The Language laboratory facilities for both Sanskrit and English language training. The Sanskrit software 'Bhashika' has been installed. The process to upgrade the facility has been done under the Centre for Excellence programme. The laboratory is used for language learning, subject learning, pedagogical training and various other purposes such as development of programmed instruction, computer assisted instruction and computer aided learning.

#### **E. Alphabet gallery**

Alphabet Gallery (Lipi Vikasa Pradarshini) was established in 2003 under the Centre for Excellence project. The gallery that was started in 2003 aims at tracing the origin, growth and development of the alphabet in India from the earliest times (3000 B.C) till the development of regional scripts (9th Century A.D.). Beginning with the script of Indus Valley civilization (3000 B.C to 1500 B.C.) the Gallery hopes to understand the complexity of the decipherment of its writing and language as understood by Dr. S. R. Rao, emeritus scientist, and archaeologist. Since the Indus script was related to the Semantic Script, Avestan and Vedic-Sanskrit languages (in phonetics, semantics, and grammar), more than it was to the Dravidian languages (as formerly interpreted by scholars), its remarkable affinity with Rig Veda in terms of Sanskrit concepts and ideas has been illustrated here.

The historical context of the Indus writing has been attempted by displaying objects, especially Seals on which the script was engraved. These seals have been found in Indus Valley sites, such as Lothal in western India during archaeological excavations during 1950-1980. The gallery also consists of models of seals from other Indus Valley sites, such as Mohenjodaro (Pakistan) and Kalibangan (India) as well as from ancient Near Eastern sites, such as Kish and Braq, Dr (Sumer- mIraq), Hissar and Bahrein. The models of Indus Valley seals, sealings, sculptures, bronzes give us an insight into the life of the people and takes the history of Sanskrit language, the, Vedic concepts and traditions to a much earlier date than what we know.

#### **F. UNIVERSITY HEALTH CENTRE**

The Health Centre functions on all University working days from 9.30 am to 6.00 pm. Emergency cases are attended on-call basis 24x7. The Health Centre provides OPD facility for treatment of general ailments. Initial emergency care will be provided to the patients in the Health Centre. Oxygenation, nebulization and ECG facilities are available at the Health Centre. The patients are provided with In-patient facilities (observation) in the Health Centre. There is one male ward with three beds, one female ward with three beds, and one male and female isolation rooms with one bed respectively. In addition, there is an executive ward with two beds for the staff/dependents of the University. Patients will be referred to the nearest Govt. Hospital / Empaneled hospitals for specialized treatment/hospitalization and other services which are not available at the Health Centre.

The Pharmacy is equipped with basic medicines, injections, surgical products, disposables, I.V fluids etc. Medicines are issued to the patients as per the prescription.

A clinical laboratory was established as part of the augmentation of the Health Centre. Routine and basic investigations such as Hematological, Pathological, Biochemical and Serological tests are carried out in the lab.

One ambulance is available at the Health Centre to deal with emergency medical situations for patient transportation from Health Centre to nearest Govt. Hospital or locally empaneled hospital.

Health education is an integral part of the University Health Centre. Health advisories are issued from time to time.

The following programs were conducted/participated by University Health Centre pertaining to medical related issues during the year 2022-23.

4. Awareness program on women health issues was conducted on 08<sup>th</sup> March 2022 by NSS through Google meet
5. COVID-19 Precautionary dose vaccination drive was conducted by University Health Centre in co-ordination with Local Health Department on 02nd September 2022.





- District level training program on Tobacco Free Educational Institutions (TOFEI) was organized on 06<sup>th</sup> September 2022







- 5K Walkathon was conducted on the World Heart Day on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022.





- Free Eye Testing Camp was arranged on 13<sup>th</sup> October 2022 in association with Dr. Agarwal's Eye Hospital, Tirupati.



- First Aid classes for B.Ed. students were conducted from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 27th October 2023.



- An Awareness program on Women's Health issues was organized on International Women's day on 08<sup>th</sup> March 2023.







- Deworming program was conducted by Health Centre team in co-ordination with Local Health Department on 15<sup>th</sup> March 2023.

### G. Staff-Quarters

The University has two Type-V quarters, eight Type-IV quarters, four Type-III quarters, four Type-II quarters and eight Type-I quarters accommodating 26 employees of the University. Out of ~~ten~~ Gurukulas Quarters, seven Gurukulas quarters are allotted to the University employees, ~~two~~ Gurukula Quarters are earmarked to the Centre for Sastra Parirakshana and one Gurukulas quarter is occupied by the Indonesian Students.

### H. Engineering

The following works were completed during the year under report.

1. Design, Supply, Installation & Commissioning of 30.5 Mtr (100ft) high National Flag Mast along with necessary hoisting mechanism and lighting at an estimated cost of Rs.22.91 lakh.
2. Construction of Platform surrounding the Flagpole at the existing stage along with construction of Gas bank at the Dining hall and laying of Old paver blocks at an estimated cost of Rs. 11.65 lakh.
3. Agama Laboratory was constructed at an estimated cost of Rs. 16.20 lakh and the facility has been put to use during the year.

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
