**Ref:** Resolution No: 7.10(a) of Seventh Executive Council.

With reference to the subject cited above, and the Executive Council resolution under reference, Memorandums of Understanding have been signed on 07<sup>th</sup> June,2022 with Amara Hospital, Karakambadi, Tirupati and Dr.Agarwal's Eye Hospital, AIR bypass Road, Tirupati for availing speciality medical services to the staff and their authorized dependants starting from 07.06.2022.

In this connection, the staff members are requested to kindly note the following:

1. The staff/ staff dependants of the University can avail cashless treatment facility for In-patient services from the said hospitals.
2. The entitlement of wards for the patients are depending upon their basic pay as per CS(MA) Rules, 1944 and CGHS. The current entitlement is as follows, in terms of GOI, No.S.11011/11/2016-CGHS(P)/EHS dated 09.01.2017.

S.No	Corresponding basic pay drawn by the officer in the 7 <sup>th</sup> CPC per month	Ward entitlement
01	Upto Rs.47,600/-	General Ward
02	Rs.47,601/- to Rs.63,100/-	Semi-Private Ward
03	Rs.63,101/- and above	Private Ward

3. With respect to Out-patient treatment facility, the cost of medicines/medical items/ accessories etc prescribed during OPD consultation shall be borne by the staff/staff dependants only. All other services such as consultation, lab investigations, imaging charges would be on cash-less basis and relevant bills would be processed by the University.
4. As regards in-patient treatment, Registrar is the Competent Authority to make a reference based on the advice of the Medical Officers or otherwise.
5. The staff/staff dependants shall produce valid Identity card issued by the University and referral letter issued by the Medical Officer, University Health Centre at the time of consultation/ admission at the hospital.
6. In case of emergency, the patient may get admitted in the said hospital and referral letter shall be obtained from the Medical Officer and shall submit in the respective hospital within 48 hrs, failing which may entail the hospital to collect the amount due as per regular charges of the respective hospital from the patient before discharge.
