INTRODUCTION

National Sanskrit University, a Central University is a premier institution in the field of higher learning in Sanskrit studies, Traditional Sastras and Sanskrit Teacher Education. It is funded by the Ministry of Education through UGC. The University has a long history in the service of Sanskrit education.

The University was established at Tirupati (A.P.) in 1961 by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the Sanskrit Commission (1957) as an autonomous body under the name of Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati Society. Dr. S. Radhakrishnan, the then Vice President of India laid the foundation stone of the Vidyapeetha on 4th January 1962. The basic objective of setting up the Vidyapeetha is to impart and improve Sanskrit Teacher Education, to accelerate the pace of higher Sanskrit learning and to combine the traditional Sanskrit education with modern scientific research.

Later, Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati came under the administrative control of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education in April 1971. In the year 1987, the Vidyapeetha was declared as a Deemed-to-be-University by Government of India, considering its service to the cause of Sanskrit Education, its achievements in research and publications and the general progress it had made in the past 25 years. It was formally inaugurated by the then President of India Sri R. Venkatraman on 26th

of August 1989. Considering its achievements and potential for research in Traditional Sastras, the University was given the status of **Centre of Excellence in Traditional Sastras** during the X , XI and XII Plans.

Considering the achievements of the Vidyapeetha in the field of Sanskrit and Traditional Sastras, the Vidyapeetha is elevated as **National Sanskrit University** (Central University) by Govt. of India by an act of Parliament in the month of March, 2020 and the university is now functioning as National Sanskrit University from 30th April, 2020.

CENTRE OF EXCELLENCE IN TRADITIONAL SASTRAS

The University has achieved a rare honour of being recognised as a Centre of Excellence in Traditional Sastras by the UGC basing on its achievements, academic excellence earned in the field of teaching and research in Traditional Sastras and its potential for future development during IX plan. The same has been extended for the X, XI and XII plan periods also.

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has accredited the **University with 'A' grade** for the period 2015-2020 (CGPA of 3.71 on Four Point Scale in Cycle-2).

The University was listed under Graded Autonomy Category – I, Deemed to be University by UGC in March, 2018.

The University has been attracting students from all over India and abroad and the programmes offered by it, cover a wide range of subjects viz. Sanskrit language and literature, Traditional Sastras, Sanskrit Teacher Education and career oriented programmes. A combination of Traditional Sastras with modern subjects like Mathematics, Computer Science, History etc., is offered at Sastri/B.A., B.Sc. (Comp.), B.Sc. in Yoga and Prak Sastri levels. A unique feature of the University is that the medium of instruction for imparting Traditional Sastras is Sanskrit.

Location

The University has a sprawling campus of 41 acres and is located at the foot of the Tirumala Hills, the abode of Lord Sri Venkateswara (Balaji) near Alipiri. The University campus, adjacent to SVIMS (Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences), is at a distance of 4 kms. from Railway Station and APSRTC Bus Station. It can be approached through Reservoir Road and Balaji Colony.

Emblem

The motto on the emblem *Tamaso ma Jyotirgamaya* speaks of the vision and idealism for which the University was established. The emblem comprises a circle, a rectangular base, two lamps on side, a bunch of palm leaves, the petals of a lotus, each of which are of immense significance. Besides, it includes the rays of the Sun which are considered to represent a perennial source of creative thoughts.

University Accredited at the A Level by NAAC

The National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) has accredited the University with “A” grade in 2015 (CGPA of 3.71 on Four Point Scale).

The University has been granted Graded Autonomy Category – I Deemed to be University by UGC. The University was given 12B status by the UGC during Deemed University period.

Infrastructure:

1. **Administrative Building:** The University has two storeyed building for administrative needs.
2. **Academic Building:** A separate building with two connected blocks is being utilized only for teaching and research. It is named after a renowned scholar; the first Vice-Chancellor of our University *Padmabushan Mahamahopadhyaya Navalpakkam Satakopa Ramamuja Tatacharya*. The building also houses a Seminar Hall.
3. **Library Building:** The library is accommodated in a spacious two storeyed building with the special arrangements for preservation of manuscripts.
4. **Education Building:** The Dept. of Education is functioning in an independent two storeyed building.
5. **Transit Hostel/Guest House:** The University has two-storeyed transit hostel/guest house.
6. **Hostels:** The University houses on its campus eight hostels. Four for boys, three for girls and one for research scholars.
7. **Staff Quarters:** The University has quarters for its teaching and non-teaching staff.
8. **Ashrama Type Study Centers:** The University has Ashrama Type Study Centers in the names of great sages and Acharyas built under Shastra Varidhi programme.
9. **Playground:** The playground takes care of all outdoor sports and games requirements

10. **Indoor-Stadium:** An Indoor-Stadium has been established with all facilities for Indoor games.
11. **Multi Gym:** A Multi Gym has been established for the benefit of students, A Gym for girls has also been established in women's hostels.
12. **Sansk-Net Centre:** A Sansk-Net Centre is established in a ground floor and one storeyed building.
13. **E-Class room:** E-Class room is a novel concept that caters to the needs of the students as e-Learning is slowly occupying a significant role in the field of education. In view of the latest developments, the University has adopted and introduced Computer Assisted Instruction in the E-Class room.
14. **Advanced Computer Centre:** It has been established for e- learning requirements.
15. **ICT Resource Centre:** The University established "Information and Communication Technology Resource Centre" with 60 Computer systems in the Academic Building.
16. **Model Career Centre:** This centre at the University has been established under the aegis of National Career Service Project of the Ministry of Labour and Employment, Govt. of India, to provide a variety of Government related services to the youth.
17. **Computer Lab for MAIMT:** A computer lab has been established for Masters in Ancient Indian Management Techniques (MAIMT) students.
18. **Prof. SBR Open Air Auditorium:** To commemorate the services of former Vice-Chancellor Late Prof. S.B. Raghunathacharya the Open-Air Auditorium has been named as "Prof. SBR Open-Air Auditorium" wherein various academic and cultural programmes of the University are conducted.
19. **Ramaranjan Mukherjee Auditorium:** This auditorium is being used to conduct seminars, workshops etc.
20. **Alternative power system:** Keeping in view the frequent Power fluctuations/break downs, University has established an alternative power system (Diesel generator) with 160 KVA with 200 litre tank capacity of Kirloskar make. This facilitates an uninterrupted power supply to the entire University.
21. **Utilization of Solar Power in the University campus:** The University through CPWD (E) has made Power Purchase Agreement (PPA) with Hero Solar Energy Pvt. Ltd. which is a Solar Energy Corporation of India (SECI) (A Government of India

Enterprise) approved bidder for 156 KW Rooftop Solar PV (Photovoltaic) Panels to utilize maximum Green Energy in the campus.

22. **Canteen:** A canteen is established with all facilities for refreshments.
23. **Bank:** A branch of Union Bank of India (R S Vidyapeetha Branch) is functioning in the University.
24. **Post Office:** A Post Office is functioning in the campus.
25. **University Health Centre:** -The University Health Centre has been established to provide primary and emergency medical services to students, research scholars, teaching and non-teaching staff, and authorized dependents in the University.
26. **"Sujalam"** Safe Drinking Water through RO System is provided to the inmates of the campus.
27. **Parents' retiring room facility:** The University provides accommodation facilities in the University campus to the parents/guardians of all the students visiting the University campus either at the time of admission or during their visits on any other occasion.
29. **Women's Facility Centre:** As per the guidelines of the UGC, the University has established one Common Facilities Centre providing various facilities for the women staff and students of the University.

30. Academic Programmes offered:

In accordance with National Education Policy (NEP) -2020, the UG Programmes of NSU are designed **with multiple exits** at the end of I Year, II year, III year and IV year.

- a) **Regular programmes:** -Prak-Sastri ; Sastri (B.A.) ; B.A. ; B.Sc.; Acharya (M.A.); MA in Hindi ; M.Sc. in Computer Science & Language Technology, M.Sc. in Yoga Therapy.
- b) **Research Programmes:** M.Phil.(Visistacharya), Ph.D.(Vidyavaridhi); D.Litt. (Vidya-vachaspati)
- c) **Online Programmes:** Short term online courses in 20 subjects have been conducted.
- d) **Diploma & Certificate Courses:** Diploma in Temple Culture; Pourohitya; Yoga Vijnana, Sanskrit and Law, Management. Certificate course in Temple Culture, Pourohitya, Functional English and Jyotisha.
- e) **Distance Education:** Prak-Sastri, Sastri (B.A.), Acharya (M.A.), Certificate in Sanskrit, Diploma in Sanskrit and P.G. Diploma in Yoga Vijnana.

- f) **Innovative Programme:** With the financial assistance of the UGC the University has been running MAIMT (Master in Ancient Indian Management Techniques) - (Two years) under innovative programme.
- g) **Bridge Course:** The Bridge course is run at the beginning of the Academic Year which is meant for improving the quality of learning in P.G. Entrants of the University.
- h) **Samskruta Vikasa Kendra:** It was started with the noble cause of University's engagement with society. Under Balakendram, spoken Sanskrit Shibirams were organized. Special lectures on Sanskrit and celebration of Birth Anniversaries of eminent people were also organized. In collaboration with TTD, a 77 episode series "Samskritam Nerchukundam " was telecast on the SVBC.

31. Projects:

(i) Orissa Chair:

The Government of Orissa has established the Orissa Chair in the University with the seed grant of Rs 50lakhs to do intensive research, to bring out publications on Lord Sri Jagannath and to highlight the contributions made by Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu and the poet Sri Jayadeva to the cultural heritage of our country. The Chair was formally inaugurated by Justice Sri Ranganath Mishra, Former Chief Justice of the Supreme court of India and Chairman, Central Sanskrit Board, Govt of India on 14th October 2000.

(ii) Shri Ramanuja Project:

Shri Ramanujacharya Project is one of the prestigious projects funded by the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, New Delhi to Digitize, Edit and Publish the manuscripts related to Saint Shri Ramanujacharya on the Occasion of the 1000th Birth Anniversary of the Shri Ramanujacharya.

(iii) Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT):

The Project is funded by the Ministry of Education, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objectives of the Project are to Address shortcomings related to teachers and teaching.

(iv) Mahabharata Telugu Translation Project:

Mahabharata Telugu Translation Project is funded by Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanam to bring out a standard text of the Mahabharata with Telugu Translation. The Co-ordinator of the project is Prof. Rani Sadasiva Murty. The work is in progress.

(V) Ashtadashi:

Rastriya Sanskrit Samsthan, New Delhi, has sanctioned a grant sum of Rs. 5,10,000/- under their scheme Ashtaadashi Projects, to prepare a critical edition of Vishnutattva Samhita - An unpublished Pancharatra text, basing on the manuscripts for the first time.

NSS Programme - The NSS volunteers went to the surrounding sub-urban areas of Tirupati and conducted normal and special camps. They also participated in Swachh Bharat Programme.

ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

Located at the sacred foot of Tirumala Hills, National Sanskrit University has been the destination for students and scholars seeking Sanskrit education for the past six decades. A veritable miniature India, the University has been drawing students from all corners of our nation, belonging to different regions, languages and creeds, for it has been providing ideal facilities and conducive atmosphere for study and research. Further, innovative and interdisciplinary courses and state-of-the-art computer facilities have made it a much sought-after institution for Sanskrit studies. Conveniently located in the centre of Tirupati town, the campus is very attractive with tall shady trees and well nurtured garden that gives a reminiscence of ancient forest groves.

THE BEGINNING:

On the recommendations of the Central Sanskrit Commission appointed by the Government of India during 1950's, a Central Sanskrit Institute was established at Tirupati in 1961 by the Ministry of Education, Government of India for the preservation and propagation of traditional Sanskrit learning combining it with the modern methods of research. The Government of India constituted an autonomous registered body called 'Kendriya Sanskrit University Tirupati Society' for the administration of the institution. The foundation stone for the Kendriya Sanskrit University was laid by the then Vice-President of India, Dr.S.Radhakrishnan on 4th January, 1962. About forty two acres of land was leased out by the prestigious Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams Trust Board, headed by the then Executive Officer, Dr.C.Anna Rao, along with a munificent donation of Rs.10 lakhs towards construction of buildings.

The Vidyapeetha Society has had a galaxy of reputed scholars and statesmen as its successive Chairmen, namely, Sri Patanjali Sastry, former Chief Justice of India being the first, followed by Prof.V.Raghavan, a reputed Indologist and Sri M.Ananthasayanam Iyengar, former Speaker of Lok Sabha. Dr. B.R. Sharma was the first Director of the Institute from 1962 to 1970. Sri Venkata Raghavacharya, Dr.Mandan Mishra, Dr.R.Karunakaran, Dr. M.D. Balasubramanyam and Prof. N.S. Ramanuja Tatacharya served the institution in the capacity of Principal in the successive years and contributed their scholastic and administrative experience to a large extent.

Kendriya Sanskrit University came under the aegis of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan – an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education in April, 1971. During the Silver Jubilee celebrations in 1987, Sri P.V.Narasimha Rao, the then Union Minister of Human Resource Development, Government of India, declared the University as a Deemed to be a University on the recommendations of the University Grants Commission under Section 3 of UGC Act 1956. (vide Gazette notification No.F.9-2/85 U-3 dated 16-11-1987). The Deemed University was formally inaugurated by the then President of India Sri R.Venkataraman on 26th August, 1989. The University started functioning as a Deemed to be University from the Academic Year 1991-92.

Since then it had eminent personalities as its Chancellors, namely, Mahamahopadhyaya Sri Pattabhirama Sastri, Prof. Ramaranjan Mukherjee and Dr. V.R. Panchamukhi. Prof. N.S. Ramanuja Tatacharya (1989-1994), Prof. S.B. Raghunathacharya (1994-1999) and Prof. D. PahladaChar (1999-2004) served the University as Vice-Chancellors. Prof. K.E. Govindan, Senior Professor of the University served as the Vice-Chancellor i/c. for two years upto April, 2006. Prof. Harekrishna Satapathy held charge from 2006 to 2016. Prof. S.S. Murthy and Prof. MLN Murthy held charge as in-charge Vice Chancellors from 2016 to 2017. Prof. V. Muralidhara Sharma took charge as Vice-Chancellor on 15.01.2017. Sri N. Gopalaswami, recipient of Padma Bhushan, former Chief Election Commissioner of India was appointed as Chancellor of the University on 21st October, 2015.

For its achievements in the fields of teaching, research, publications and promotion and propagation of Sanskrit, the University has been bestowed with distinctive recognitions:

- Recognised by the UGC as Centre for Excellence in the subject of Traditional Sastras.
- Accredited with CGPA of 3.71 on four point scale at 'A' Grade by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2015.
- UGC Granted 12-B Status to the University.
- The University was ranked best Deemed to be University among three Sanskrit deemed to be universities by 'Tandon Committee' appointed by MHRD, Govt. of India, New Delhi.
- The UGC has granted graded autonomy [Category I] to the Rashtriya Sanskrit University, Tirupati on 20-03-2018.

In its illustrious journey, the Sanskrit vidyapeetha has attained the status of Central University as National Sanskrit University in April 2020 with the passing of Central Sanskrit Universities Act, 2020 by the Indian Parliament.

I. ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

The note on the implementation of National Education Policy (NEP)-2020:

1. As per the instruction of Ministry of Education, Government of India, NSU Tirupati has been implementing the NEP-2020 guidelines since the later half of 2020. In this process, syllabi on UG and PG level in all the Departments have been retired / reviewed. Keeping in view, the multi disciplinary and inter disciplinary elements.
2. A task force committee with 40 internal as well as external has been constituted to implement all the guidelines in a gradual manner.
3. A committee has been constituted to prepare modalities for implementation of ABC i.e. Academic Bank of Credits.
4. And as per the guidelines of NEP-2020 in the UG levels of NSU, the multiple entries and exists principle also is being considered to be implemented from 2022-23 Academic Year for which ground work has been done in the later part of 2020.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE FOR REGULAR PROGRAMMES:

The Academic Year of the NSU begins in June second/third week and concludes in April (Next year) with the conduct of examinations. Semester pattern is being followed in all UG and PG Programmes. Admissions into Prak-Shastri and Shastri / BA programmes, MAIMT programmes are made on the basis of marks secured in the qualifying examination and personal interview. Admissions into the Acharya (M.A.) programme Siksha Shastri (B.Ed.), Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.) and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) are based on the entrance test conducted by the NSU at national level. Holders of NET/SLET/M.Phil are exempted from the entrance test for Vidyavaridhi. Scholars can pursue research under full time or part-time basis. The admission notifications for all the programmes are placed on the NSU **website:** <http://www.nsktu.ac.in>. Shastras in all programmes are taught in Sanskrit medium only and the examination is conducted in Sanskrit. For modern subjects the medium of instruction and examination is English and for other languages the respective language is the medium of instruction and examination.

EXAMINATIONS:

- ❖ For UG and PG Programmes semester pattern of examination is followed.
- ❖ For Prak-Sastri (eq. to intermediate) Annual pattern of exam is followed. The examination for all the non-semester courses i.e. Certificate, Diploma/PG Diploma along with Prak-Sastri is held in the month of March and April, 2020 due to corona pandemic all the exams were conducted online.

Merit Scholarships are awarded to students on the basis of their percentage of marks/merit obtained in the last qualifying examinations. Students of Prak-Sastri I year, II year, Sastri I, II, III years and students of each sastra in Acharya I and II years are given Merit Scholarships.

SWAMY SIVANANDA MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Swamy Sivananda Memorial Scholarships were instituted by the Swami Sivananda Divine Life Society, Rishikesh and Haridwar. An amount of Rs.10.20 lakhs has been released to the University as a Corpus Fund. The University has presented cash prize awards worth Rs. 5,000/- and an appreciation certificate to the toppers of both first and second year students of Acharya level in 10 Sastras i.e., Sahitya, Vyakarana, Dharma Sastra, Advaita Vedanta, Visistadvaita Vedanta, Dvaita Vedanta, Nyaya, Puranetihasa, Mimamsa and Vedabhashya.

Implementation of Reservation Policy

The University has been strictly implementing the rule of reservation for SC, ST, OBC, EWS and PwD candidates as per the directions issued by Govt. of India and UGC from time to time in the case of admission of the students to various courses Prak-Sastri, Sastri, Acharya, SikshaSastri (B.Ed.), Siksha Acharya (M.Ed.), M.Phil. and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) and also in the case of appointments i.e. Teaching and Non-Teaching staff.

II .Professional programmes

School of Education

The Department of Education provides a pre-service programme in Sanskrit for preparing teachers for secondary school. It is also involved in preparing self-learning kits for learning Sanskrit and in developing Sanskrit pedagogical research. The following professional programmes are offered under this department:

III. Non-formal Education:

Education is a continuous process and is not constrained / restricted to particular age. The system of distance Education has emerged as an alternative to accommodate the growing needs of education in the present modern world.

Distance education system fulfills the needs of all those who could not pursue a normal formal college education system (or) who were not able to complete their studies due to financial problems/others (or) to those who would like to improve their knowledge.

In order to enrich the hidden treasure of Sanskrit and to protect the importance and usefulness of Sanskrit language and Literature, Directorate of Distance Education has been established in the year 2003 with the financial support from *Distance Education council (DEC)/Distance Education Bureau (DEB)/University Grants Commission (UGC)* for preparation of course materials and for students support ever since it has been actually functioning under the aegis of *DEC / DEB / UGC*.

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati, has been declared as **National Sanskrit University, Tirupati** under the Act of Parliament during the year 2020. Subsequently, as per the University Grants commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 [Sl.No.8 (3)] the Directorate of Distance Education has been renamed as **Center of Distance and Online Education** from 29.03.2021 and included all the Online Programmes.

Presently, Prof. G.S.R.Krishna Murty, Professor, Dept. of Sahitya has been assigned with the responsibility of Director for the Center of Distance & Online Education.

B. RESEARCH

ADMISSIONS - The University offers Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) in Sahitya/ Vyakarana/Jyotisha (Phalita, and Sidhanta) Nyaya/Advaita Vedanta/ Visistadvaita Vedanta/ Dvaita Vedanta/Vedabhashya/Agama and Education. The Sanskrit version of the degree will bear the name Vidyavaridhi and the corresponding English version of the degree will be **DOCTOR OF PHILOSOPHY**. In the Academic Year 2020-21, a total number of 350 Students took admission into Vidyavardhi programme (as on 31.03.2020).

D. TRAINING

The following UGC/Government Schemes are in operation

(a). REMEDIAL COACHING CENTRE

Objective:

The University has started Remedial, JRF-NET and “Entry into Services” coaching centres for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, OBC (non-creamy layer) and Minority students from the Academic Year 2007-2008 with the financial assistance from University Grants Commission. The students belonging to other categories and who are in need are also permitted to attend the coaching classes. During the Academic Year 2020-21, classes were conducted to the students in online mode on Saturday and Sunday.

The following programmes were covered:(1) Acharya I Year (2) Acharya II Year (3) Sastri I Year (4) Sastri II Year (5) Sastri III Year (6) Prak-Sastri I Year (7) Prak-Sastri II Year and (8) SikshaSastri (B.Ed.).

(b). COACHING CLASSES FOR ENTRY INTO SERVICES FOR SC/ST/OBC (NON-CREAMY LAYER) AND MINORITY COMMUNITY STUDENTS

The UGC [vide their letter No. F/No.RSVT/SC/ST/OBC XII Plan Scheme dated 15.9.2016 has sanctioned Coaching Classes for Entry into Services for SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) and Minority Community Students to the University for the benefit of the students studying in the institution.

Objective of the scheme: The objective of the scheme is to provide coaching of good quality for economically disadvantaged Scheduled Castes (SCs), Scheduled Tribes (STs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) candidates to enable them to appear in competitive examinations and succeed in obtaining appropriate jobs in public/private sector. Prof. P. Venkata Rao, Professor, Dept. of Education is the coordinator for the programme. During the Academic Year 2020-21, classes were conducted to the students in online mode on Saturday and Sunday.

(c). NET Coaching Centre: NET coaching classes were organised during the year 2020-21. Prof. Satyanarayan Acharya is the Coordinator.

(d). Model Career Center: Established under the aegis of National Career service project of Ministry of Labour and employment, Government of India. The centre provided training to youth for availing job opportunities.

(e).Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC):

An Internal Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) is functioning in the University and Prof. Pralhad Joshi is the Director, IQAC. During the period of report IQAC has initiated various steps for quality improvement in the University, IQAC has been actively preparing for re-accreditation by NAAC. Some of the important activities and initiatives of IQAC are as given below:

1. Enrolled for NAAC Cycle 3 ranking,
2. Collection of various info for preparation of NAAC SSR.
2. Started preparation of NAAC SSR and AQAR for the last five years which is nearer for completion.
3. Issued 2 notifications for teachers promotion under CAS.
4. Calculated API scores of 16 CAS applicants by constituting scrutiny committees. Accordingly, promotions are recommended.
5. Participated in the NIRF Ranking.
6. Collected Profiles of Teachers and made them available on the University website.
7. Created a new window in the name of IQAC in which the University website hosted various useful information.
8. Given valuable quality enhancing suggestions in Entrance Test and admission procedure.
9. Created a Teacher Database.

During the FY 2020 – 21, no activities done in the Model Career Centre (MCC) due to COVID. Sofar, no Young Professionals were deployed from Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, New Delhi.

II. CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Co-Curricular Activities:

- **Vagvardhini Parishad**, Due to covid-19 pandemic, no activities were held.
- **Maxmuller English Club**, a voluntary organisation run by the students themselves, under the guidance of the staff of the English Department, aims at developing the oratory and communicative skills in English of the students of the University. Due to covid-19 pandemic, no activities were held.
- **Tulasidas Hindi Parishad**, is an organisation to help students widen their knowledge in Hindi Language and Literature. Due to covid-19 pandemic, no activities were held.
- **Annamacharya Sahitya Kalaparishad**, offers scope for students to enrich their literary knowledge and improve their language skills in Telugu. Due to covid-19 pandemic, no activities were held.

Sanskritika Kalaparishad:

A cultural organisation involving students and Faculty members, Sanskritika Kalaparishad conducts training programmes in performing arts, organises cultural events, thus bringing out the talents of the students. It also prepares cultural teams for participation in Inter-University Youth festivals etc.

In addition to these the students participate in many co-curricular activities including Music, Drama, Sports, and other Literary competitions conducted in other Universities also. This year due to covid-19 pandemic, the students are not able to participate in any inter university competitions.

Sports & Games

The university has a separate department of Physical Education providing regular training to the students in Sports and Games throughout the year. The University has a well equipped and spacious Indoor Stadium with wooden flooring catering to the needs of the students. Another special feature is the addition of a gymnasium with 16 pieces of equipment placed in a separate room in the Indoor Stadium. The latest and modern equipment such as Treadmill, Abdomen Machine, Leg Vibrator Machine, Cycling Machine etc., are the additional equipment available in the Indoor Stadium. The women's hostel is also provided with a separate gymnasium, exclusively for women students. This facility enables students to improve their physical fitness. The University has a spacious playground with eight lanes 400mts running track with two galleries and provision for playing Cricket, Football,

Volleyball, Ball – Badminton, Kabaddi, Kho - Kho etc., and also for conducting sports. The students of the University have been participating in All – India and South Zone Inter University competitions held in sports and games. There is one separate building consisting of one store room, two dressing rooms separately for boys and girls. Due to Covid-19 pandemic, the entire sports activities in the country were stopped with no participation on behalf of the university.

V. PROJECTS

A. Orissa Chair

The Government of Orissa has established the Orissa Chair in the University with the seed grant of Rs 50lakhs to do intensive research, to bring out publications on Lord Sri Jagannath and to highlight the contributions made by Sri Chaitanya Mahaprabhu and the poet Sri Jayadeva to the cultural heritage of our country. The Chair was formally inaugurated by Justice Sri Ranganath Mishra, Former chief justice of the Supreme Court of India and Chairman, Central Sanskrit Board, Govt of India on 14th October 2000. So many research activities are going on in the Odisha Chair for the preservation and propagation of the main aim and activities.

1-Car festival of Sri Jagannath Mahaprabhu observed by the Chair. Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. V. Muralidhar Sharma Inaugurated the festival, Prof. G.S.R.Krishna Murthy, Registrar i/c, Adviser of Odisha Chair, and Prof. Rani Sadashiva Murthy Dean Academic Affairs, all NSU teaching and non teaching staff and other dignitaries were also present there on 24.07.2020, Friday.

2-A two day National Webinar on **Sri Jagannath Culture** was organised on 3rd & 04th February 2021 by the Odisha Chair. 7-Students are coming to the Chair on Various festivals and rituals to learn the procedure to perform worship. The Odisha Chair acts as a "Prayog Saala" for students.

(ii) **Shri Ramanuja Project:**

Sri Ramanuja (Ramanujar; traditionally 1017–1137), also known as Ramanujacharya, was a theologian, philosopher, and scriptural exegete. He is seen by Sri Vaishnavas as the third and most important acharya (teacher) of their tradition, and by Hindus as the leading expounder of Visistadvaita, one of the classical interpretations of the dominant Vedanta school of Hindu philosophy. Sri Ramanujacharya is regarded as the father of Sri Vaishnava Philosophy. Sri Ramanujacharya was instrumental in spreading the Sri Vaishnava Philosophy extensively throughout India. His philosophy is called Visistadvaita, which is a refined Advaitam of Sri Adi Shankaracharya, a great saint and Philosopher of the 8th century. Visistadvaita of Sri Ramanujacharya is very popular when compared to the other philosophies

because it has revealed many secrets of the Vedantic Philosophy. That's why millions of people follow the Visistadvaita Philosophy of Sri Ramanujacharya.

SHRI RAMANUJACHARYA PROJECT AND N.S.UNIVERSITY, TIRUPATI:

On the Occasion of the 1000th anniversary, the responsibility has been handed over to the *Dept. of Visistadvaita Vedanta of N.S.University (Erstwhile Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha), Tirupati* to conceptualize and implement the project with the financial support of the Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, New Delhi so that some more resources of the philosophy of Saint Ramanujacharya would be brought into the literary, academic and general use.

THE PROJECT -

The National Sanskrit University (Erstwhile Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha) Tirupati was sanctioned with a major project namely "Shri Ramanujacharya Project" with an amount of Rs.118.33 lakh funded by the Ministry of Cultural Department, Govt. of India for digitising, Editing & Publishing of Manuscripts related to saint Shri Ramanujacharya on the occasion of the 1000th Birth Anniversary of the saint and released the 1st instalment of Rs.29.50 lakhs. In the process, various rare manuscripts from many libraries were procured and are being digitized.

C. Mahabharata Telugu Translation Project

Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams sanctioned Rs.60 lakh Mahabharata Telugu Translation Project to the University. The duration of the project is 18 months. The objective of the project is to bring out a standard text of the Mahabharata with Telugu translations. Prof. Rani Sadasiva Murty is the program Coordinator.

From January 2020 the project team is working for the best outcome of the project in all the way. In connection with this all the Moolaslokas which were in iLeap are converted to Unicode, Mandali font as per MoU. Total Slokas are 93,634 in number. 1. **Admin website** – which will be used to upload the translated Slokas into the website from time to time.
2. **User website** - Which will provide a detailed searchable program to the user. The user can search Parva Sloka, Upaparva Sloka, Upakhyana Sloka, Adhyaya Sloka, searching Slokas using a word in whole Mahabarata and Pictorial expression of Mahabharata, Stories of Each Parva, Astras used in Mahabharata, Vyuhas of Mahabharata, Names etc.,

D. Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers & Teaching (PMMMNMTT)

The Project is funded by the Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India, New Delhi. The objectives of the Project are to Address shortcomings related to teachers and teaching:

To Meet shortage of teachers, Create and strengthen the institutional mechanisms, improve quality of teaching and empower teachers and faculty through training, re-training, refresher and orientation programmes, Create a sufficient base of teacher educators, Prepare faculty for academic leadership positions, Capacity building for curriculum development, assessment, and teaching and learning material. Prof. Pralhad R. Joshi, Dean, Faculty of Education is the Coordinator.

Under PMMMNMTT SCHEME SBN was sanctioned in the year 2017-18. In the 2020-21 funds were not released. Hence no activity is conducted.

VI. INFRASTRUCTURE

A. Library

The National Sanskrit University Library is named the Mahamahopadhyaya Sri PattabhiramaSastri. The library has the largest collection of learning resources on Sanskrit studies, Traditional Sastras, and Pedagogy. The library supports research and educational endeavors of students, research scholars, and the faculties of the university by collecting, organizing, preserving, and disseminating information and providing instructional programs in all formats through need-based services. It enables access to online information resources using modern information and communication technologies.

The university library is automated with state-of-the-art integrated library management software (SOUL). The library is using Colon Classification (CC) system to organize the knowledge collection. The library has a good collection of documents on all subjects and the total collection of books is around 1,14,483 apart from 166 Indian and Foreign periodicals. The library has more than 4000 manuscripts with 8105 titles in different languages like Sanskrit, Telugu, Tamil and in different scripts such as Devanagari, Grantha, Telugu, Kannada, Tigalari etc.

The library has become a member of INFLIBNET by which it would be providing information and reference data about Sanskrit through networking and also about national and international Sanskrit scholars.

B. Hostels

Guest House

The University Guest House consists of Ground+2 floors. There are total 19 rooms with 2 bedded rooms-12, 3 bedded rooms – 5 & Suite rooms-2. A dining hall with a kitchen is also available in the Ground Floor. These rooms are mainly meant for guests from MoE, UGC etc. who visit University on official purpose. Based on the availability, rooms will be allotted to staff guests also.

Men's Hostel

The University has been maintaining 4 hostels for men students, Viz. Garudachala, Neelachala, Vedachala and Seshachala. In addition to these hostels one separate hostel is available for accommodating the research scholars. In these hostels, two separate messes with attached kitchens preparing and serving exclusively north Indian & south Indian cuisine are for the benefit of the students hailing from different parts of the country.

Womens' hostel

The University has 3 separate hostels, Viz. Padmachala, Vidyachala & Vakulachala for women students and in addition to these there is one dormitory. All the women students from Prak-Sastri to Vidyavaridhi are accommodated in these hostels. A mess with a kitchen is also maintained in the women hostels.

To augment the intake of hostellers, a new hostel complex is being constructed with an approximate intake of 500 students, with the funding from HEFA.

C. Psychology Laboratory

To facilitate training students of Education in a scientific manner the Psychology laboratory of National Sanskrit University is established in the Department of Education. The Laboratory is well equipped with Computers, Projectors and Furniture. It has been serving a useful purpose for B.Ed. and M.Ed. students in building their mental and cognitive abilities.

D. Language Laboratory

The Language laboratory has facilities for both Sanskrit and English language training. The Sanskrit software 'Bhashika' has already been installed. The process to upgrade the facility has been done under the Centre for Excellence programme. The laboratory can be used for language learning, subject learning, pedagogical training and various other purposes such as development of programmed instruction, computer assisted instruction and computer aided learning.

E. Alphabet gallery

Alphabet Gallery (LipiVikasaPradarshini) was established in 2003 under the Centre for Excellence project. The gallery started in 2003 aims at tracing the origin, growth and development of the alphabet in India from the earliest times (3000 B.C) till the development of regional scripts(9th Century A.D.). Beginning with the script of Indus Valley civilization (3000 B.C to 1500 B.C.) the Gallery hopes to understand the complexity of the decipherment of its writing and language as understood by Dr. S. R. Rao, emeritus

scientist and archaeologist. Since the Indus script was related to the Semantic Script, Avestan and Vedic-Sanskrit languages (in phonetics, semantics and grammar), more than it was to the Dravidian languages (as formerly interpreted by scholars), its remarkable affinity with Rig Veda in terms of Sanskrit concepts and ideas has been illustrated here.

The historical context of the Indus writing has been attempted by displaying objects, especially Seals on which the script was engraved. These seals have been found in Indus Valley sites, such as Lothal in western India during archaeological excavations in 1950-1980. The gallery also consists models of seals from other Indus Valley sites, such as Mohenjodaro (Pakistan) and Kalibangan (India) as well as from ancient Near Eastern sites, such as Kish and Braq, Dr (Sumer- mIraq), Hissar and Bahrein. The models of Indus Valley seals, sealings, sculptures, bronzes give us an insight into the life of the people and takes the history of Sanskrit language, the, Vedic concepts and traditions to a much earlier date than what we know.

F. ICTRC Activities:

The Information Communication Technology Resource Centre was started with 60 computer systems in the Academic Building with the main objective of catering the ICT needs of the Academic and administrative wings of the University. Since the day of setting up ICTRC it has been looking after the following activities.

- The ICTRC Center has focused on implementation of Sanskrit Self learning platform for the students enrolled in the programmes offered by National Sanskrit University.
- It has organized Google Suite and Microsoft Teams Orientation Programme for faculty of National Sanskrit University, making efficient use of the teaching and learning tools from 20-11-2020 to 25-11-2020.
- The computational resources were made available for faculty and students for working on various SWAYAM, MOOCS and NMEICT
- In house web based applications for online Application, Admission, Fee Management system and hosting them online. ICTRC has also extended all cooperation for taking up -admission related activities like online application system, Online Admission System, online examination process, fee management during corona pandemic.
- Working together with Administrative authorities for implementation of SAMARTH Project in National Sanskrit University
- Training was imparted to Vidyavaridhi/Acharya students to take up scanning of Rare Sanskrit text books in the library.
- Devised simple methods using open source tools to capture online attendance relating to regular online academic activities
- Multilingual interface for sansknet Data is being developed and tested for migration to production.

- Initiated Smart University Campus Project with EDCIL for setting up rugged LAN and future University computational requirements.
- Managing University's Digital Social Media activities.
- Implementing NAD-Digilocker for NSU.

F. University Health Centre:

National Sanskrit University, Tirupati greatly values the health of its students and staff members. The health centre has been established to provide comprehensive primary and emergency medical services to students, research scholars, teaching and non-teaching staff, and their authorized dependents of the University. The health centre also looks after the social, preventive and environment of the campus.

FACILITIES:

- **OPD services:** The health centre provides OPD services from 9.30 am to 6.00 pm on all University working days and in emergency cases on call service will be provided 24x7.
- **IP Services:** The health centre has two emergency beds for day care procedures and it is equipped with oxygen and nebulisation facilities to treat emergency medical conditions.
- **LAB Services:** The University has proposed to establish a computerised clinical laboratory to perform basic blood, urine, sputum and stool investigations at the health centre.
- **PHARMACY Services:** Most of the medicines required for OP treatment are dispensed at the health centre itself.
- **AMBULANCE Services:** For emergency services, there is a 24x7 ambulance facility available on the campus.
- **DRESSING ROOM FACILITY:** Health centre has one dressing room facility for treatment of minor injuries, wounds and day-care procedures.

The health centre is committed to promoting the health and wellness of the campus community by providing high-quality prevention, education and treatment services. The health centre aims to enhance the health care experience of the university campus community by providing health care with respect, consideration and maintaining confidentiality.

H. INDOOR STADIUM:

- Indoor Sports training facility consists of two wooden floored Badminton Courts, one room for two Table Tennis Boards, two Rooms for playing Chess and Carroms, one room for other equipments like Vibrator Machines for abdomen, Treadmill, Cycling, and other exercise equipments and one Multi-Gym.
- Multi-Purpose Gymnasium with 16 station multi-gym is having the facility of Hip Flexor, High Lat Pulley, Abdominal Bench, Rowing Machine, Hyper-X-Tention, Twister, Arm press, Preacher Curl, Pec Deck, Leg Curl, Dipping, Leg Press, Squat Press, Pull Ups, Preacher, Bench Press and all other individual stations are also available in Gymnasium.

G. Staff-Quarters:

The University has two Type-V quarters, eight Type-IV quarters, ten Gurukulas, four Type-III quarters, four Type-II quarters and eight type-I quarters accommodating 36 employees of the University.

G. Engineering:

Construction of the Boys Hostel

The NSU through CPWD has Constructed a 500 seated Boys Hostel with a sanctioned amount of Rs: 29.53 Cr through HEFA funding. The Boys hostel consists of 167 rooms for accommodation, 03 reading rooms, 01 sick room, 01 warden room along with 01 Recreation Hall, apart from washrooms where work is in progress.

Construction of the Classroom Complex

The NSU through CPWD has constructed a Classroom Complex Building with a sanctioned amount of Rs: 27.26 Cr including furniture portion through HEFA funding. The Classroom complex consists of 17 class rooms, 01 studio, 02 virtual class rooms, 3 e-class rooms, 02 conference halls, 03 meeting halls, 32 rooms apart for members of faculty from wash rooms where work is in progress.

Installation of Sewage Treatment Plant of 150 KLD capacity

The NSU through CPWD have installed a 150 KLD capacity Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) with a sanctioned amount of Rs: 2.00 Cr towards making use of treated sewage water for Horticulture developments in the campus.

Installation of CC Cameras and Biometric Systems

The NSU through CPWD have installed 101 CC Cameras along with 21 Biometric Systems with a sanctioned amount of Rs: 98.35 lakhs for the purpose of safety and security.
