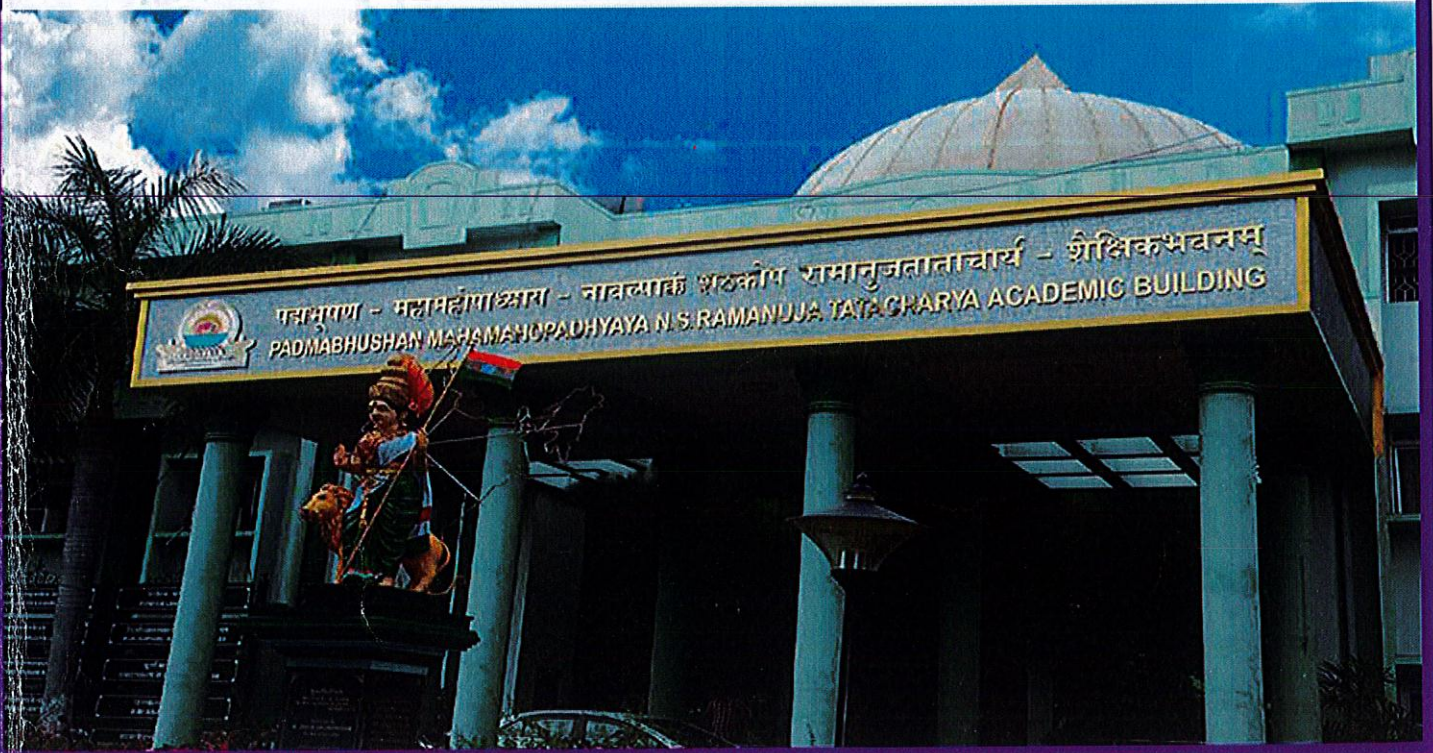

1. The University Grants Commission vide its letter no. F.14-22/201 (Inno./ASSIST.) dated 28-02-2011 has sanctioned its assistance for the programme PG Diploma in Comparative Aesthetics in Global Perspective in the Department of Sahitya under Innovative programmes being one year programme for the period from 01-04-2011 to 31-03-2016. The PG Diploma course was commenced with the approval of the Vidwat Parishad in its 23rd meeting vide item no.23.10 dated 18-07-2011.

2. The UGC vide its letter no.F.14-46(A)/2012 (Inno/Assist), dated 20th January, 2012 has sanctioned its assistance for the programme "Masters in Ancient Indian Management Techniques" (MAIMT) in the Department of Sastras under Innovative Programme to the Vidyapeetha for the period from 01-04-2012 to 31-03-2017.

As per UGC sanction letter (in both the courses) it has been clearly stated that "An assurance from the University/Institute/college that the approved course will continue after the UGC assistance to the programme ceases." The Vidyapeetha has continued these two programmes for the academic year 2017-18 as per the recommendations of the sub-committee of the Academic Council vide item no. 10.

The Deans' Council item no.01 dated 24th April, 2018 (enclosed as Annexure-03 vide pg.nos.42 to 45) has recommended to continue these programmes from the academic year 2018-19 and on regular basis.

Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, a university established under section 3 of the UGC act, 1956 is a premier institution in the field of higher learning in Sanskrit Studies, Traditional Sastras and Pedagogy. The Vidyapeetha has a long history in the service of Sanskrit Education.

The Vidyapeetha introduced Computer Science course in the Research programmes from the academic year 2014-15 vide Academic council item no.26.11 dated 24-05-2014. Only three members are admitted in this computer science course in research programmes till date. The Vidyapeetha is conducting Combined Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test every year with the co-ordination of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan, New Delhi and Sri Lal Bahadur Sastri Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, New Delhi. But the other two institutions are not offering the computer science course at research level.

Hence, as per the recommendations of the Deans' Council Item No.4 dated 24-04-2018 for discontinuation of the Computer Science course in Research programmes is to be approved. (enclosed minutes of the Deans' council as Annexure-03 vide pg.nos.42 to 45)

The Vidyapeetha provides scholarships to its students on the basis of their percentage of marks, merit obtained in the last qualifying examination. Scholarship will be given for 10 months only. Presently the Vidyapeetha is providing scholarship as follows –

To bring uniformity of the scholarships to the graduate and post-graduate programmes, the Deans' Council has recommended to enhance the scholarship to Siksha Sastri and Siksha Acharya students on par with Sammanita Sastri and Acharya students i.e., Rs.350/- and Rs.400/- respectively and it is to be implemented after getting approval from the Finance Committee of the Vidyapeetha.

It is also resolved to permit the students to pay the admission fee semesterwise for the above programmes or else yearwise as per their convenience.



More than 1,000 specially chosen faculty and teachers from across the Country have participated in preparing these courses.

The courses hosted on SWAYAM are in 4 quadrants – (1) video lecture, (2) specially prepared reading material that can be downloaded/printed (3) self-assessment tests through tests and quizzes and (4) an online discussion forum for clearing the doubts. Steps have been taken to enrich the learning experience by using audio-video and multi-media and state of the art pedagogy / technology.
