## Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) Between

### Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati And

### French Institute of Pondicherry

Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati, A deemed University under UGC with A+ grade in NAAC Assessment, located at Tirupati – 517 507, Andhra Pradesh, India represented herein by its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or permitted assigns; hereinafter referred to as 'RSVT' of the **Second Part**.

### And

The French Institute of Pondicherry setup by the "Treaty of Cession" in 1955, located at 11 Saint Louis Street, Puducherry – 605 001, India represented herein by its nominees, successors and permitted substitutes or permitted assigns; hereinafter referred to as 'IFP' of the Second Part.

### WHEREAS

RSVT offers study programs and courses and conducts research in the range of academic fields covering Language, Linguistics, translation and literature, Darshanas and Shastras, Vedanta, Jyotisha, Yoga, Manuscriptology, Traditional Studies, Ancient Indian Studies, Vedic Studies, and Education, etc.

### AND WHEREAS

IFP is a research institution under the joint supervision of the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the French National Centre for Scientific Research (CNRS). IFP consists of Department of Indology, Department of Social Sciences, Department of Ecology and GeoSMIT. Department of Indology is working on Indian analyses of Sanskrit Language and Literature, History of Religion, Tamil Studies and Architectural and Religious Heritage of South India.

RSVT and IFP mutually agree that the encouragement and development of cooperation and exchange in all areas of mutual academic interest is desirable. Both parties, therefore, wish to expand the basis for partnership and cooperative educational exchange and have set forth the following MoU.

### Article 1

The memorandum of Understanding should be flexible by nature for allowing necessary amendments from time to time with mutual consent.

The purpose of this MoU includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- To organize Seminars/Conferences/Workshops/Summer Schools etc either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.
  - O To organize joint academic activities related to ancient Indian studies' such as conferences, seminars, workshops, summer schools, symposia and lectures at either ends
  - Hospitality will be borne by the hosting Institute.

- O TA and DA for the resource persons will be borne by the respective institution from both ends.
- > Exchange of staff (academic and research) either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.

It is agreed that linkages will be strengthened by personnel visits and exchange between the collaborating institutions. The purpose is to exchange relevant information and develop specific cooperative projects and programs.

O The purpose, timing and other details concerning exchanges and short visits

shall be mutually acceptable to the institutions.

O RSVT and IFP agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculty and scientists from the two institutions. Specifically, the institutions would encourage members of their faculty to undertake short visits or take up fixed term visiting assignments as visiting professor.

It is agreed that information concerning the purpose and duration of faculty and research visits, the research backgrounds of personnel and further details, as required, will be provided to the host institutions at least two months prior

to the proposed visits.

The terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning travel allowances, boarding and lodging would be worked out between concerned faculty member and the institution extending an invitation.

O Notwithstanding the above, RSVT and IFP will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund international travel by their

faculty/scientists/technical staff.

> Exchange of students either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.

The main objectives of this program are

O To expose students to various forms of acquiring maximum knowledge in minimum time

o To expose students to the similarities and differences between the institutions

in social, educational and environmental issues

o To enhance the students ability to assess and understand the culture of new groups of people, in order to function effectively as a contributing member of the given community

o To help students to be ambassadors for their institution and region.

To achieve the above objectives, it is agreed to

O Exchange students at both post-graduate and research level

o The visiting student or research scholar shall be permitted to utilize the resources of the hosting institution such as library, computer system etc.

o An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the

host institution during period of approved visit.

O His/her program of study or research at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor or research supervisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor or research co-guide indentified by the host institution

o If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out

- o If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedure
- o The number of students, stipend/scholarship, period of stay etc can be decided by mutual agreement
- Exchange of Manuscripts (Palm leaf/Paper) & publications of common interest RSVT and IFP have well established manuscript libraries. The rich heritage and abundant knowledge is hidden in these ancient Indian scriptures. These manuscripts have significant scientific, historical or aesthetic values. All these manuscripts are found in different languages and scripts. If we bring out the knowledge in these scriptures it will be very much useful to the contemporary world.

To achieve the above objective it is agreed that

- O Both the institutions shall permit their research scholars to carry out research and publish the manuscripts available at both the ends.
- O The results of such research work can be published jointly by the two institutions
- o RSVT & IFP agree to provide the soft copy of the manuscripts on written request from the respective institutions
- ➤ Collaborative projects ensuing from this Memorandum of Understanding may include any of the academic disciplines represented at the two institutions.

### Article 2

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results achieved, as well as arrangement for visits, exchanges, and other forms of collaboration will be further discussed and developed mutually for each specific case. All financial will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.

In order to carry out and fulfil the goals of this MoU, both parties will appoint coordinators for the development and management of joint activities. Through these contact persons, either party may initiate proposal for activities under this MoU. Specific details will be set forth in a letter of MoU which will form part of this general arrangement following the signature by the appropriate authorities of both parties. A letter of MoU will include such items as:

- > Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the activities agreed upon
- > Schedules for the specific activity
- > Budgets and sources of financing for each activity
- Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity. The contact persons shall be responsible for the evaluation of activities under this MoU according to the practices of the respective Institutions. Letters of MoU will be approved by both sides according to the normal procedure adopted by the signatory party.

### Article 3

Any kind of disagreement against this MoU from either side may be settled through discussions by both the parties and not through any agency of law.

### Article 4

This MoU shall initially be valid for five years from the date of signing and can further be continued on the basis of its success in the initial period. It shall be reviewed by both parties six (6) months prior to the expiry and may be renewed for a further term under mutual acceptance.

The MoU becomes valid from the day of signature by both the parties. It is renewed by mutual agreement, by means of a written amendment, between the parties for similar periods, in accordance with the applicable procedure in each institution.

Any modification of this MoU is subject to the prior written consent of both parties. This MoU may be terminated by either party at any time provided that the terminating party gives a minimum of three (3) month notice in writing at the address mentioned above.

Accordingly, the number of seats in UG shall be on par with B.Sc. in Yoga programme and any Prak-Sastra/Intermediate/or any equivalent examination passed candidates are eligible. It is also resolved to hold Board of Studies for Translation studies and Fine arts to prepare syllabus for an Instrumental Music and Dance.
- 5. It is recommended to approve all Certificate/Diploma/PG Diploma programs under the Evening College wing. In addition, Certificate and Diploma programmes in Sanskrit are also proposed to be introduced to meet the demand of general public who wish to learn Sanskrit. It is resolved to offer certificate programme in Sanskrit and Certificate programme in Ancient Indian Mathematics. All the Evening college certificate, Diploma and PG Diploma are self financed programmes.
- 6. It is recommended to approve the introduction of counseling cells like Vastu / Jyotisha / Paurohitya on consultation fee for meeting the needs of the General public.
- 7. It is recommended to take all necessary measures by Heads and all faculty members to maintain students' attendance for not less than 75% through Mobile attendance, manual attendance books and any other means. In case of the failure of students' attending classes such defaulters will not be given scholarship.
- 8. Further it is resolved to provide two centralized typists (NMRs) in ICT labs to help the Faculty in getting their academic documents get typed.
- 9. It is also resolved that there should be one Computer period for all the programmes in ICT lab.
- 10. It is resolved to appoint co-ordinators for Prak-Sastri I year, Prak-Sastri II year, Sastri I year and Sastri II year students to monitor the attendance, discipline and such academic participation of the students of the said years.





# OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) in civil posts and services in the Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions.

In pursuance of insertion of clauses 15(6) and 16(6) in the Constitution vide the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019 and in order to enable the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes, to receive the benefits of reservation on a preferential basis in civil posts and services in the Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions, it has been decided by the Government to provide 10% reservation to EWSs in civil posts and services in Government of India and admission in Educational Institutions.

- Persons who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for 2. the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes and whose family has gross annual income below Rs. 8.00 lakh are to be identified as EWSs for the benefit of reservation. Family for this purpose will include the person who seeks senefit of reservation, his/her parents and siblings below the age of 18 years as also his/her spouse and children below the age of 18 years. The income shall include income from all sources i.e. salary, agriculture, business, profession etc. and it will be income for the financial year prior to the year of application. Also persons whose family owns or possesses any of the following assets shall be excluded from being identified as EWSs, irrespective of the family income:
  - 5 acres of Agricultural Land and above;
  - ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
- ii. Residential flat of 1000 sq. ft. and above;
  iii. Residential plot of 100 sq. yards and above in notified municipalities;

- The income and assets of the families as mentioned in para 2 would be required to be certified by an officer not below the rank of Tensildar in the States/UTs. The officer who issues the certificate would do the same after carefully verifying all relevant documents following due process as prescribed by the respective State/UT.
- Every Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority, increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of study or faculty so that the number of scats available, excluding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EWSs, are not less than the total scats available in the academic session immediately preceding
- Instructions regarding reservation in employment and admission to educational institutions will be issued by DoPT and Ministry of HRD respectively.

# THE CONSTITUTION (ONE HUNDRED AND THIRD AMENDMENT) ACT, 2019

[12th January, 2019.]

An Act further to amend the Constitution of India.

BE it enacted by Parliament in the Sixty-ninth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment) Act, 2019.

Short title and commencement.

- (2) It shall come into force on such date as the Central Government may, by notification in the Official Gazette, appoint.
- 2. In article 15 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

Amendment of article 15.

- '(6) Nothing in this article or sub-clause (g) of clause (1) of article 19 or clause (2) of article 29 shall prevent the State from making,-
  - (a) any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5); and
  - (b) any special provision for the advancement of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clauses (4) and (5) in so

far as such special provisions relate to their admission to educational institutions [PART II—SEC. 1] including private educational institutions, whether aided or unaided by the State, other than the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (1) of article 30, which in the case of reservation would be in addition to the existing reservations and subject to a maximum of ten per cent. of the total seats in each

Explanation.—For the purposes of this article and article 16, "economically weaker sections" shall be such as may be notified by the State from time to time on the basis of family income and other indicators of economic disadvantage.

Amendment of article 16.

3. In article 16 of the Constitution, after clause (5), the following clause shall be inserted, namely:-

"(6) Nothing in this article shall prevent the State from making any provision for the reservation of appointments or posts in favour of any economically weaker sections of citizens other than the classes mentioned in clause (4), in addition to the existing reservation and subject to a maximum of ten per cent. of the posts in each

Subject: Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission in Central Educational Institutions.

In accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (One Hundred and Third Amendment). Act 2019, and the reference of Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment vide OM No. 20813/01/2018-BO-II dated 17th January 2019 enabling provision of teservation for the Economically Weaker. Sections (EWSs) who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservations for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and the Socially and Educationally Backward Classes. If has been decided to provide reservation in admission to educational institutions subject to a maximum of ten-per cent of the total seats in each category. This would not apply to the minority editational institutions referred to in clause (1) of Article 30 of the Constitution of India:

2. The provision of reservations to the Economically Weaker Sections shall be in accordance with the directions contained in the OM No. 20043/01/2016 BC III dated 17th January 2019 of the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment and shall be subject to the following:

a) The reservations shall be provided to EWSs for admission in Central Educational Institutions, (as defined in clause (d) of section (2) of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act 2006) from the academic year 2019-20 physics.

by The above reservation would not be applicable to the 3 institutions of excellence, research institutions, institutions of national & strategic importance as appellied in the Schedule to The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006, as amended from time to time, and appended to this QM, and to the minority educational institutions referred to in clause (if) of anicle 30 of the Constitution.

c) Every Central Educational Institution shall, with the prior approval of the appropriate authority (as defined in clause (c) of section 2 of The Central Educational Institutions (Reservation in Admission) Act, 2006), increase the number of seats over and above its annual permitted strength in each branch of

study or faculty so that the number of seals available, exoliding those reserved for the persons belonging to the EMSE, is not less than the minuter of such seats available, in each category, for the academic session immediately preceding the date of the coming into force of this O.M.

d) Where, on a representation by any Central Educational Institution, the appropriate authority is satisfied that for teasons of financial physical or academic limitations or in order to maintain the standards of education, the actual permitted strength in any princip of study or faculty of such institution cannot be increased for the goademic session following the commencement of this Aut, it may permit such institution to increase the almust permitted strength over a maximum period of two years beginning with the academic session following the commencement of this Act, and then, the extent of reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections shall be inflied for that economic section in such manner that the highber of seats made available to the Economically Weaker Sections for each predemic session shall not reduce the number and the percentage of reservations provided for 90/5000 BC categories.

The scheme for implementing the reservation for the EWS shall be displayed on the website of the institution as soon as possible, but no later than 31st March

2019.

3. The Chairman UGC Chalung AICTE and Chairperson NCAE and the Bureau Heads of the Department of Flighter Education Inditie Ministry of Human Resource Development responsible for management of the institutions of National Importance are requested to ensure immediate compliance of this OM.
