The objective is to provide access to the best quality learning resources across the country, the project 'Study Webs of Active Learning for Young and Aspiring Minds' (SWAYAM).

The Ministry of Human Resource Development has framed guidelines with a view for systematic development of the MOOCs for the SWAYAM.

Prior to introduction of the MOOCs, steps such as — Identifying the purpose and nature of the course and the target/time-line/objective/assessment strategy etc., modalities have to be framed.

The Deans council in its meeting held on 10-02-2017 [vide annexure-VII(Page Nos.28-29)] has approved in principle for introduction of MOOCs from the Academic Year 2017-18.

### REPORT ON THE 11TH AISSTF - 2017

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha conducted the 11th All India Sanskrit Students Talent Festival in its campus premises from 30th January to 2nd February 2017 with much gaiety and fervour. Organized with the noble idea of providing a platform to the Sanskrit students from all around the country, to test their caliber and performance in various academic and cultural events, the Festival witnessed 259 students coming from all corners of the country from about 22 Sanskrit Institutions this year. Mahamopadhaya and President Awardee, Prof Viswanatha Gopalakrishna, Ex Principal, Gautami Vidyapeetham, Rajamundry inaugurates the Festival as the Chief Guest and K.E.Devanathan, Vice Chancellor, SV Vedic University was the Guest of Honour. The inauguration function began on on 30th January at 10 am in the SB Raghunathacharya Open Air Auditorium in the Vidyapeetha premises. Prof R.L.N. Sastry, Dean, Academic Affairs welcomed all the dignitaries, students, institutions and their guides. Dr C.Ranganathan was the master of the ceremony. The Chief Guest and the Guest of Honor gave an inspiring message to the participating students and stressed that students should read traditional texts with renewed interest and should dedicate their lives for the propagation of Sastras and Sanskrit. Dr Bharat Bhusan Rath, Additional Coordinator, Vagvardhini Parishad proposed the vote of thanks and the inaugural program ended with the rendering of the National Anthem.

Post inauguration, the ANTYAKSHARI Competition was held on the afternoon of January 30<sup>th</sup>. Almost 40 students participated in this competition and went on for more than 3 hours. The last half an hour witnessed a verbal duel between the last two competitors and finally a winner emerged. The evening witnessed two cultural events viz Singing and Mono-acting. Almost 20 competitors took part in the Singing Competition. Prof P.N.Sastri, Vice Chancellor, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan and Prof Hriday Ranjan Sharma, Ex-HOD, Dept of Veda, Banaras Hindu University were special invitees and they thoroughly enjoyed the mellifluous Sanskrit songs rendered by the contestants. The invitees were also felicitated on this occasion. The Mono-acting competition saw the participants don various historic roles and they put up an entertaining act which the audience enjoyed to the fullest.

The morning session of 31<sup>st</sup> January saw elocution competitions in Veda, Sahitya, Jyotisha and Mimamsa. Students took part in them with great enthusiasm and displayed their oratory skills. The judges put forth grueling questions to test the proficiency of the students in their respective subjects. While some answered them, others were simply baffled by the nature of the questions. In the afternoon session, elocution competitions on Nyaya, Puranetihasa, Vyakarana and Sankhya were conducted. Evening was the time for **One Act Play.** As many as 15 teams participated in the event and skits ranging from historic to current social events kept the audience glued to their seats. The event continued till the wee hours of the night.

On 1<sup>st</sup> April, elocution competitions on Vedanta and Dharmasastra were conducted followed by SAMSYAPURTI, wherein a question/puzzle was given and participants had to answer/solve them in a poetic manner. A Quiz competition was conducted in the afternoon and seven teams, who got selected after a preliminary test, took part in the event. Questions ranging from Sastras and Puranas to sports and music tested the students' aptitude in various subjects. The next event was Folk Dance and students participated with great enthusiasm. Various dance styles were showcased in the event and the audience was left spellbound by some of the versatile performances.

Altogether 13 Academic and 4 Cultural Competitions were conducted.

The Valedictory Program commenced at 11 am on 2<sup>nd</sup> February. PadmaBhushan Sri N.Gopalaswami, Chancellor of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha was the Chief Guest of the event. Speaking on the occasion, he gave a call for the entire Sanskrit fraternity to collectively make efforts for the propagation of Sanskrit. He also stressed the need to bring out rare manuscripts lying in various libraries and repositories in the country in print format, thereby unearthing the treasure trove of knowledge in various subjects. The Vice-Chancellor, Prof V.Muralidhara Sharma, speaking on the occasion, congratulated all the winners of various events and students. the spirit applauded the PANINEEYAVYAKARANAODAHARANAKOSA - TADDHITAPRAKARANAM was released by the Honorable Chancellor Sri N Gopalaswami on this occasion. This book was published jointly by RS Vidyapeetha, Tirupati and French Institute of Pondicherry.

Winners of the various competitions were awarded with medals,cash prize and certificates. The participating institution which wins the maximum number of competitions is given a *ROLLING SHIELD* and The *ROLLING SHIELD* for the 11<sup>th</sup> AISSTF – 2017 went to the host institution – *Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha*, Tirupati He stressed the need for in-depth study of the traditional Sastras. Dr O.G.P.Kalyana Sastry, Additional Coordinator, Vagvardhini Parishad



proposed the vote of thanks and the program ended with the rendering of the National Anthem.

In connection with the 11<sup>th</sup> All India Sanskrit Students Talent Festival, a book exhibition-cum-sale was held in the premises of the Vidyapeetha. A special discount of 40% was given on all the publications brought out by the Vidyapeetha. Also, a Sanskrit – Science Exhibition and an Alphabetical Gallery were put on display for the citizens of Tirupati. The Sanskrit – Science Exhibition contained information about various scientific facts embedded in the Ancient Sastras. Information about various subjects like Physics, Geology, Gemology, Chemistry, Astrology were put to display and students from various educational institutions from Tirupati flocked to witness the display. The Alphabetical Gallery contained the gradual evolution of various scripts in the Indian Sub-continent and this display too attracted the interest of many students.

Sub: Proposal to prepare English Textbooks for Prak-Shastri Course - Reg.

The syllabus in the Prak-Shastri (I & II year) Course consists of an English Reader, a Supplementary Reader, Grammar & Writing Skills (each year).

While the Supplementary Readers are outside publications and bought from the bookshops/market, the Main Readers are Vidyapeetha publications. They were published in the years 1997 & 1998 for I & II years. Since then, they are in use till today. Considering the usage of the texts for over a long period of time (2 decades), I plan and propose for the preparation of two New Readers; moreover, with the developments in Science & Technology over the globe, the need for communication skills in English has been gaining importance; and the contents of the present Readers too appear outdated. The methodology in the teaching of the foreign language also calls for a relook.

This formed one of the issues in the Agenda of Board of Studies meeting in the Department earlier. The Board members had resolved to prepare New Readers as the texts in use in the State and Central run schools do not prove useful to the Sanskrit students and their background. They suggested that the project can be taken up by the Faculty in the Department of English. But due to various reasons, the work fell through.

Keeping in mind the dire necessity and urgency in introducing new syllabus (with New Readers), the thought occurred to me in taking up this herculean task.

Minutes of the meeting with Heads of Departments held on 09-2-2017 at 4.00 PM in the Vice-Chancellor's Ex Chamber in the Academic Building to consider the matters on Visishtacharya (M.Phil.) and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work, as applicable to Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha (Deemed University), Tirupati as per UGC [Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph. D. Degree] Regulations 2016.

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#### BACKGROUND

The meeting started with brief introduction by Prof. R.L.N. Sastry, Dean, Academic Affairs about the focus of the meeting. The Heads of the Dept were appraised about the some of the salient features of UGC [Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph. D. Degree] Regulations 2016 and also it was informed that said Regulations came into effect from 5<sup>th</sup> July 2016 on publication in Govt. of India Gazette. Therefore, the M.Phil/Ph.D. degrees being awarded are to be fully in compliance with the Regulations 2016.

Prof. Viroopaksha V Jaddipal, HoD, Research and Publications brought following points to the notice of all HoDs present in the meeting.

#### Visishtacharya (M.Phil.)

- 1. The M.Phil Course work of 1<sup>St</sup> semester has 16 credits(4 papers) and separate credits are prescribed for dissertation.
- 2. The Vidyapeetha being 5-days week Institute, a semester has 18 weeks for class-room transaction and full year has 36 weeks for class-room transaction. Therefore, an M.Phil course has to be run for 36 working weeks (excluding exams. Preparation, holidays etc).
- 3. A paper taught for 4 days in a week upto 18 weeks amounts to 4 credits. i. e. 18 hours teaching amounts to one credit in taught paper.
- 4. The minimum credit to secure a pass in M.Phil is 24 and 55% is required in aggregate (1<sup>St</sup> semester and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester separately).
- 5. Credit and hour stipulation has to be followed. Therefore, each paper will have 72 hours of class room teaching with 4 credits for 100 Marks. 75 for external exams and 25 for internals.
- 6. It is necessary to have 24 credits, as minimum attainment to get M.Phil degree.
- 7. Therefore, 16 credits for 1<sup>st</sup> semester (4 papers, each of 4 credits/ 100 marks) and 25 credits for dissertation and 2 credits for viva voce.



- 8. 25 credits for dissertation are calculated as follows. 5 hours of dissertation work per day for 18 weeks (90 days; 90x5=450 hours which is equal to 25 credit work)
- 9. The minimum passing marks will be 50 in each semester end paper and 55 % shall be aggregate/B Grade in UGC 7 point scale. 55 % shall be a minimum for dissertation and viva voce separately.
- 10. As of now there are 3 papers, 1<sup>st</sup> paper on Research methodology and other two papers are dealt by concerned departments. With effect from June 2017 onwards, an additional paper is introduced in M.Phil on 2(a). संस्कृतभाषाकोशलम्, शोधप्रबन्धलेखनप्रशिक्षणं च for 60 marks (45 +15) 2(b). Computer Applications for 40 marks (30 +10), as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper which will be taught by dept of research. Previous papers will be numbered as 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> papers, they will be taught by concerned dept.
- 11. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester, it is necessary to show 18 weeks of work on a dissertation after the declaration of semester results in M.Phil. Therefore, with effect from 8-02-2017 the dissertation work is considered as part of semester and from this date, 18 weeks work has to be shown. Therefore, M.Phil dissertation will be allowed to be submitted in the last week of June 2017. The exact date will be notified by the CE.
- 12. During the vacations, guides may instruct the M.Phil scholars for dissertation correction, DTP and proof reading work which the scholars can do independently and consult the guides through internet etc.

#### Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work

- 1. Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) programme will be for 3 years (not two years) which includes the period of course work for 6 months.
- 2. From January 2017 onwards Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work shall be for 300 marks instead of 200 till December 2016 and there will be 12 credits; each paper having 4 credits. Credit and hour stipulation has to be followed. Therefore, each paper will have 72 hours of class room teaching with 4 credits for 100 Marks. 75 for external exams and 25 for internals.
- 3. The minimum passing marks will be 50 in each external paper and 55 % shall be aggregate/B Grade in UGC 7 point scale.
- 4. Now with effect from January 2017 onwards, an additional paper is introduced in Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work on 2(a). संस्कृतभाषाकौशलम्, शोधप्रबन्धलेखनप्रशिक्षणं च for 60 marks (45 +15) 2(b). हस्तलेखशास्त्रम्, पाठसमालोचनं च for 40 marks (30 +10), as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper.
- 5. M.Phil qualified scholars (admitted in to Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) programme) may be exempted from Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work as per 7.6 of UGC Regulation 2016. However, there is a chance that without course work certificate the degree may not be recognized equally in all places.
- 6. As per practice in Vidyapeetha, M.Phil qualified scholars will be given course work certificate (without grade) noting the 7.6 of exemption clause on the basis of papers studied in M.Phil. If they need Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Course work certificate with grade in UGC 7 point scale, M.Phil qualified scholars have to attend 10% of classes in each paper and complete other assignment and computer practicals etc.

## CVVET Compulsory for Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.)

1. All Heads of Dept were apprised that CVVET is compulsory for all candidates (with M.Phil.,/PhD/NET/JRF/SLET etc) for admission into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) of RSVidyapeetha. No candidate will be exempted from CVVET from June 2017.

2. After getting through the test, while admission in the Vidyapeetha, the M.Phil qualified candidates may be given weightage for considering their knowledge,

work, proficiency and scholastic achievements.

The HoDs discussed the issues in threadbare and RESOLVED to accept and adopt the proposal as applicable to all departments conducting M.Phil and Vidyavaridhi in the

Vidyapeetha.

It is also RESOLVED to recommend that in view of the UGC Regulation-2016 came in to effect from 5th May 2016, a certificate may be given by the CE mentioning the credithour format while issuing the Provisional certificate for the batch 2016-17 so that the students shall not face any difficulty.
