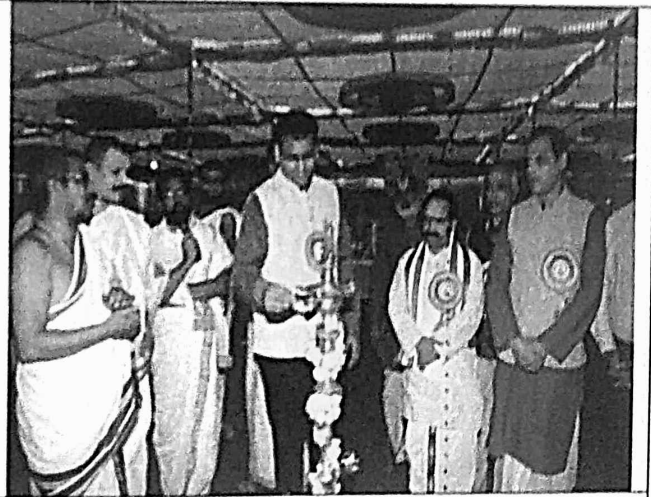


A Report on 12<sup>th</sup> All India Sanskrit Students Talent Festival - 2018

Organized with the noble idea of providing a platform to the Sanskrit students from all around the country, to test their caliber and performance in various academic and cultural events, the Festival witnessed 300 students coming from all corners of the country from about 26 Sanskrit Institutions this year.

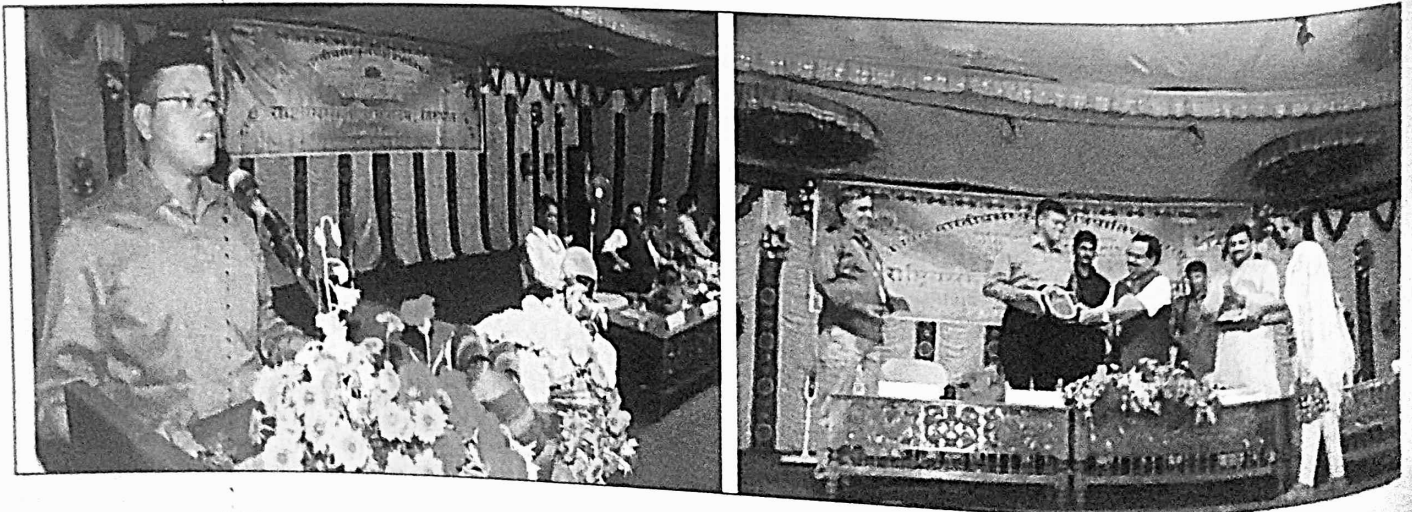

Mr. P.S.Pradyumna (I.A.S.) Collector, Chittoor District was inaugurates the Sanskrit Science Exhibition as the Guest of Honor of the programme. The inauguration function began on on 31<sup>st</sup> January at 10 a.m. in the SB Raghunathacharya Open Air Auditorium in the Vidyapeetha premises. Prof. V.Muralidhar Sharma the Vice - Chancellor of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati was the Chairman of the 4 day long mega programme. Prof. Ch.P. Satyanarayana, the Registrar of R S Vidyapeetha was present in the function. Prof R.L.N. Sastry, Dean, Academic Affairs welcomed all the dignitaries, students, institutions and their guides. Dr.Bharat Bhusan Rath, Coordinator of programme delivered the aims & objectives of the Talent Festival. 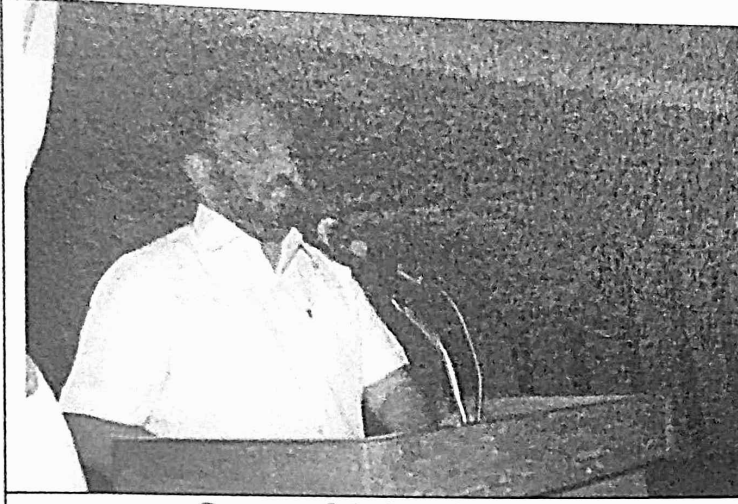

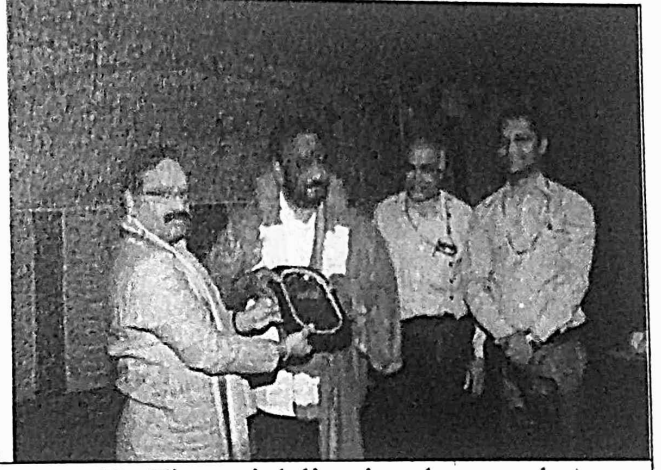

All total Five (Five) cultural competitions and 13 (Thirteen) academic competitions have organized in the 4day long Talent Fest. The Competitions are:

### Academic Competitions:

Altogether 13 Academic competitions were conducted in this four day programme. The morning session of 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018 saw elocution competitions in Sahitya, Vyakarana Nyaya & Jyotisha . In the afternoon session, elocution competitions on Sankhya, Veda, Puranetihasa & Dharmashastra were conducted. On 2<sup>nd</sup> of February, elocution competitions on Vedanta and Mimamsa were conducted followed by Samasyapoorti, wherein a question/puzzle was given and participants had to answer/solve them in a poetic manner. A Quiz competition was conducted in the afternoon and seven teams, who got selected after a preliminary test, took part in the event. Questions ranging from Sastras and Puranas to sports and music tested the students' aptitude in various subjects. Students took part in them with great enthusiasm and displayed their oratory skills. The judges put forth grueling questions to test the proficiency of the students in their respective subjects. While some answered them, others were simply baffled by the nature of the questions.

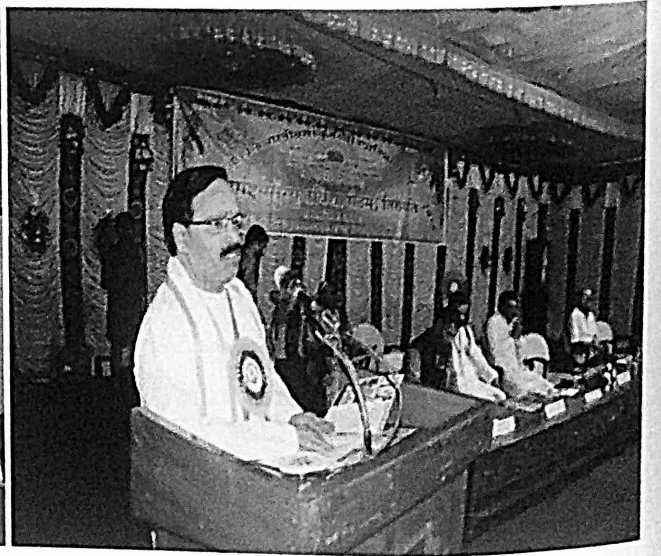
## VALEDICTORY FUNCTION:

## VIJAYA VAIJAYANTI (WINNING SHIELD)

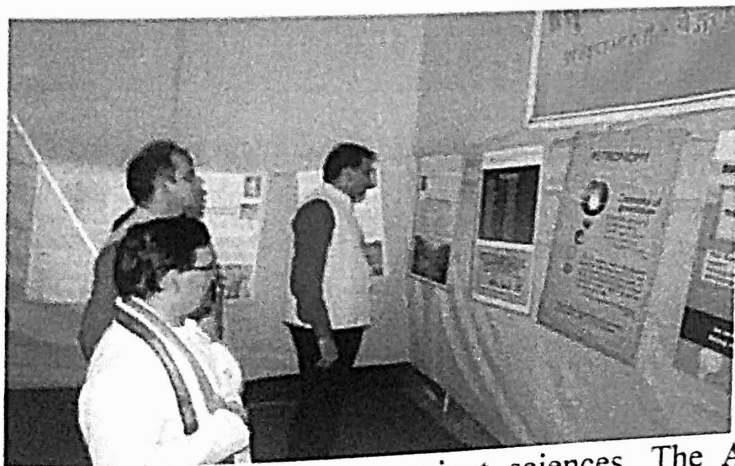

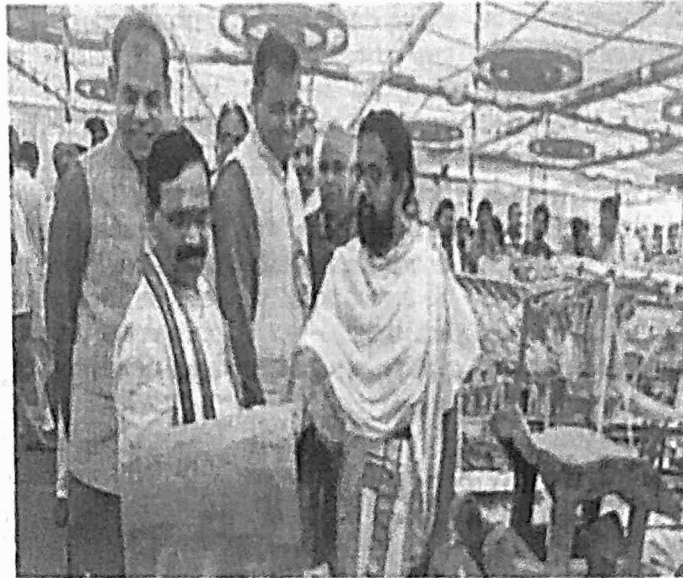
# Reviving Vedic knowledge, 'need of the hour'

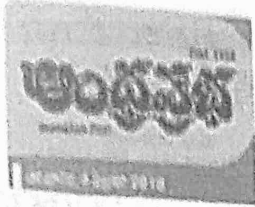
the language to the people.

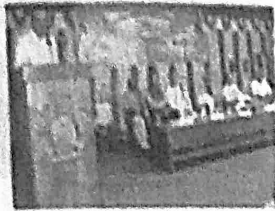
Chittoor district Collector P.S. Pradyumna urged the denizens to utilise the services of the RSVP in learning the language and lose the popular notion of it being a tough subject.
