expand the basis for partnership and cooperative educational exchange and have set forth the following MoU.

Article 1

The memorandum of Understanding should be flexible by nature for allowing necessary amendments from time to time with mutual consent.

The purpose of this MoU includes, but is not limited to, the following:

- > To organize Seminars/Conferences/Workshops/Summer Schools etc either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.
 - O To organize joint academic activities related to ancient Indian studies' such as conferences, seminars, workshops, summer schools, symposia and lectures at either ends
 - o Hospitality will be borne by the hosting Institute.
 - o TA and DA for the resource persons will be borne by the respective institution from both ends.
- > Exchange of staff (academic and research) either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.

It is agreed that linkages will be strengthened by personnel visits and exchange between the collaborating institutions. The purpose is to exchange relevant information and develop specific cooperative projects and programs.

- o The purpose, timing and other details concerning exchanges and short visits shall be mutually acceptable to the institutions.
- o RSVT and IFP agree to explore ways of encouraging collaboration between faculty and scientists from the two institutions. Specifically, the institutions would encourage members of their faculty to undertake short visits or take up fixed term visiting assignments as visiting professor.
- o It is agreed that information concerning the purpose and duration of faculty and research visits, the research backgrounds of personnel and further details, as required, will be provided to the host institutions at least two months prior to the proposed visits.
- O The terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment, including those concerning travel allowances, boarding and lodging would be worked out between concerned faculty member and the institution extending an invitation.
- O Notwithstanding the above, RSVT and IFP will examine ways to identify financial resources to fund international travel by their faculty/scientists/technical staff.
- Exchange of students either through external research projects funds or through sponsorships.

The main objectives of this program are

- o To expose students to various forms of acquiring maximum knowledge in minimum time
- O To expose students to the similarities and differences between the institutions in social, educational and environmental issues
- o To enhance the student's ability to assess and understand the culture of new groups of people, in order to function effectively as a contributing member of the given community
- O To help students to be ambassadors for their institution and region.

To achieve the above objectives, it is agreed to

- O Exchange students at both post-graduate and research level
- O The visiting student or research scholar shall be permitted to utilize the resources of the hosting institution such as library, computer system etc.
- o An exchange student will be considered as full-time "exchange" student at the host institution during period of approved visit.
- o His/her program of study or research at the host institution will be determined by mutual consultation between his/her academic advisor or research supervisor at the home institution and his/her "interim" academic advisor or research co-guide identified by the host institution
- o If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the host institution will evaluate the exchange student's performance in the research, and issue a letter to that effect, together with a technical "report" of the research carried out
- o If an exchange student has undertaken research, then the home institution will take note of the performance evaluation and the technical report, and take steps in accordance with its own procedure
- > The number of students, stipend/scholarship, period of stay etc. can be decided by mutual agreement
- Exchange of Manuscripts (Palm leaf/Paper) & publications of common interest RSVT and IFP have well established manuscript libraries. The rich heritage and abundant knowledge are hidden in these ancient Indian scriptures. These manuscripts have significant scientific, historical or aesthetic values. All these manuscripts are found in different languages and scripts. If we bring out the knowledge in these scriptures it will be very much useful to the contemporary world.

To achieve the above objective, it is agreed that

- O Both the institutions shall permit their research scholars to carry out research and publish the manuscripts available at both the ends.
- o The results of such research work can be published jointly by the two institutions
- RSVT & IFP agree to provide the soft copy of the manuscripts on written request from the respective institutions
- > Collaborative projects ensuing from this Memorandum of Understanding may include any of the academic disciplines represented at the two institutions.

Article 2

Themes of joint activities and conditions for utilizing the results achieved, as well as arrangement for visits, exchanges, and other forms of collaboration will be further discussed and developed mutually for each specific case. All financial will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.

In order to carry out and fulfil the goals of this MoU, both parties will appoint coordinators for the development and management of joint activities. Through these contact persons, either party may initiate proposal for activities under this MoU. Specific details will be set forth in a letter of MoU which will form part of this general arrangement following the signature by the appropriate authorities of both parties. A letter of MoU will include such items as:

- > Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the activities agreed upon
- > Schedules for the specific activity
- > Budgets and sources of financing for each activity

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- O Exchange students at both post-graduate and research level
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- > Elaboration of the responsibilities of each institution for the activities agreed upon
- > Schedules for the specific activity
- > Budgets and sources of financing for each activity

> Any other items deemed necessary for the efficient management of the activity

The contact persons shall be responsible for the evaluation of activities under this MoU according to the practices of the respective Institutions. Letters of MoU will be approved by both sides according to the normal procedure adopted by the signatory party.




