REPORT ON THE 11TH AISSTF - 2017

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha conducted the 11th All India Sanskrit Students Talent Festival in its campus premises from 30th January to 2nd February 2017 with much gaiety and fervour. Organized with the noble idea of providing a platform to the Sanskrit students from all around the country, to test their caliber and performance in various academic and cultural events, the Festival witnessed 259 students coming from all corners of the country from about 22 Sanskrit Institutions this year. Mahamopadhaya and President Awardee, Prof Viswanatha Gopalakrishna, Ex Principal, Gautami Vidyapeetham, Rajamundry inaugurates the Festival as the Chief Guest and Prof K.E.Devanathan, Vice Chancellor, SV Vedic University was the Guest of Honour. The inauguration function began on on 30th January at 10 am in the SB Raghunathacharya Open Air Auditorium in the Vidyapeetha premises. Prof R.L.N. Sastry, Dean, Academic Affairs welcomed all the dignitaries, students, institutions and their guides. Dr C.Ranganathan was the master of the ceremony. The Chief Guest and the Guest of Honor gave an inspiring message to the participating students and stressed that students should read traditional texts with renewed interest and should dedicate their lives for the propagation of Sastras and Sanskrit. Dr Bharat Bhusan Rath, Additional Coordinator, Vagvardhini Parishad proposed the vote of thanks and the inaugural program ended with the rendering of the National Anthem.

Post inauguration, the **ANTYAKSHARI** Competition was held on the afternoon of January 30th. Almost 40 students participated in this competition and went on for more than 3 hours. The last half an hour witnessed a verbal duel between the last two competitors and finally a winner emerged. The evening witnessed two cultural events viz **Singing** and **Mono-acting**. Almost 20 competitors took part in the Singing Competition. Prof P.N.Sastri, Vice Chancellor, Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan and Prof Hriday Ranjan Sharma, Ex-HOD, Dept of Veda, Banaras Hindu University were special invitees and they thoroughly enjoyed the mellifluous Sanskrit songs rendered by the contestants.

In connection with the 11th All India Sanskrit Students Talent Festival, a book exhibition-cum-sale was held in the premises of the Vidyapeetha. A special discount of 40% was given on all the publications brought out by the Vidyapeetha. Also, a **Sanskrit – Science Exhibition** and an **Alphabetical Gallery** were put on display for the citizens of Tirupati. The **Sanskrit – Science Exhibition** contained information about various scientific facts embedded in the Ancient Sastras. Information about various subjects like Physics, Geology, Gemology, Chemistry, Astrology were put to display and students from various educational institutions from Tirupati flocked to witness the display. The **Alphabetical Gallery** contained the gradual evolution of various scripts in the Indian Sub-continent and this display too attracted the interest of many students.
