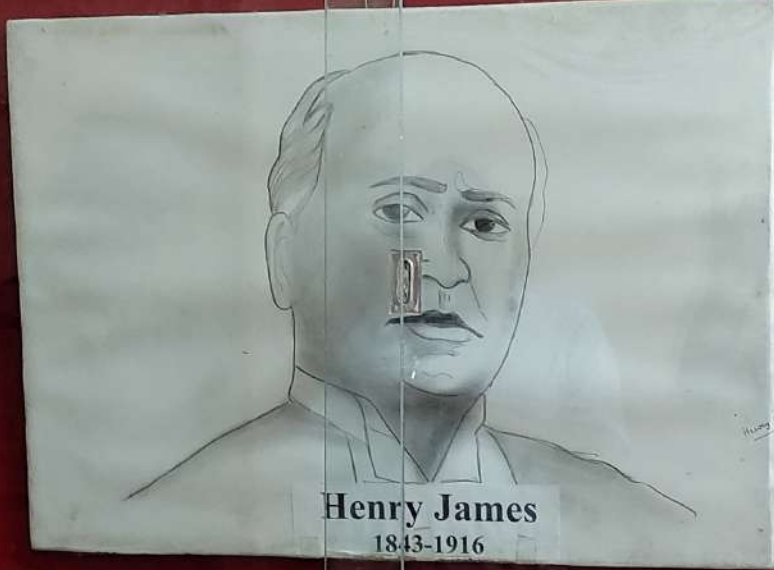

Do You Know?

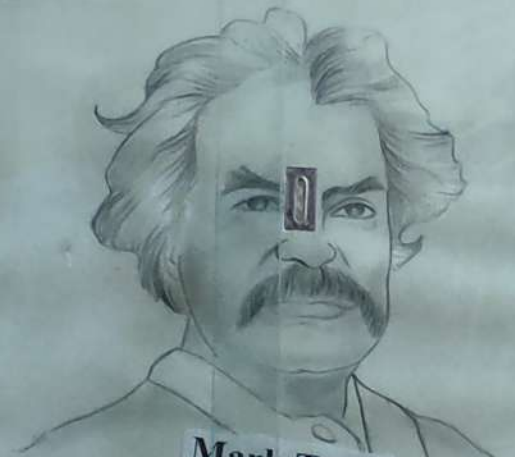
