REPORT MATRUBHASA DIVASA- 2019

The Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati organized the "Matribhasha Diwas" (Mother Tongue Day) to promote mother tongues and cultures of the Nation in a prestigious manner. In this connection, many competitions were organized in various languages. Vagvardhini Parishad, one of the active literary wings of Vidyapeetha, was entrusted with the responsibility of conducting various program as per the instruction issued by the MHRD, Govt of India - New Delhi, vide the letter Dated 02th February, 2017. The Elocution competition was organized on 16th February 2017. It was organized in two places viz. Women Facilities Centre – 1 and Women Facilities Centre – 2. Narendra, the Dept of English, Sri Venkateswara University and a noted Language expert was invited as the Chief Guest of the Function. He gave a complete picture about the linguistic diversity existing in our country and the importance of mother tongue. Being a native Telugu speaker, he threw light on the historical evolution of the language and spoke about the peaceful coexistence of other regional languages back in the day. He also lamented that globalization has affected the nature of languages and very rarely do we come across speakers today who speak original, unadultered Telugu.

Prof. V Muralidhara Sharma, the Vice Chancellor was the President of the event who gave a very inspiring speech about how Sanskrit learners have a considerable edge over other learners when it comes to learning a new language as Sanskrit is the mother of all mother tongues. He mentioned the measures, the Vidyapeetha has already taken to promote various mother languages through different activities of Vagvardhini Parishad, Tulasi Das Hindi Club and Annamaya Sahitya Kala Parishad.
