**CIRCULAR**

Sub: NSU - Academic - changing of programme in PG programmes viz., Acharya, M.A in Hindi., M.A.-Sabdabodha, M.Sc. Comp., M.Sc. in Yoga & M.A.I.M.T. for the academic year 2022-23- Reg.

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All First year students of PG programmes viz., Acharya, M.A in Hindi, M.A.-Sabdabodha, M.Sc. Comp., M.Sc. in Yoga & M.A.I.M.T. admitted during AY 2022-23 are hereby informed as follows :

- 1) The Programme Registration Numbers of the first year students of various programmes admitted during AY 2022-23 are appended herewith. The students may note that the Registration Numbers are to be quoted in all the correspondence with the University henceforth.
- 2) The students desirous of changing their Programme are hereby informed to submit their fresh request letters as per the following provisions of the NSU Admission Regulations 2022. Subject to eligibility condition and availability of seats, the same shall be considered:
  - a) Clause No.10.3: After the admission into a prescribed programme, the candidate, subject to satisfaction of the eligibility criteria, can be permitted to change into another programme, within fifteen days from the date of admission. Any such requests after the expiry of fifteen days shall not be entertained under any circumstances. The fee paid (excluding all fees under Administrative Process Fee as defined in NSU Academic Ordinance No.05) shall be carried forward to the new programme and balance, if any, shall be payable by the candidate.
- 3) The section will give a circular after consulting the ERP cell for the selection of the Discipline specific elective within a short time.
- 4) Accordingly, the last dates for submission of the above requests for change of Programme is on or before: 05-12-2022
- 5) The Coordinators of all the PG Programmes are requested to coordinate with the HODs / faculty members and arrange counseling & guidance sessions to the newly admitted students.
- 6) HODs / faculty members are requested to contact the respective Programme Coordinators for counseling & guidance sessions to the newly admitted students in their respective subjects to enable the students to make an informed decision regarding changing their Programme and/or Elective courses.
- 7) Further, the students who did not open / submit the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) ID are hereby requested to open the ABC Account on their own or take the assistance of the ERP Cell of the University in the SanskNet Building and submit the same immediately without fail.
