

GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1. Mere possession of eligibility conditions shall not entitle a candidate to be called for interview. The date for determining the eligibility of all candidates in every respect shall be the last date and time as prescribed in this notification for receipt of the online applications. In other words, a candidate shall not be called for interview if he/she does not possess the minimum qualification and experience etc., for the post as on the last date of receipt of the online applications as prescribed in this notification.
- 2. Acceptance of documents/certificates/claims etc. submitted by an applicant will be subject to their verification by the competent authorities. If any claim/certificate/document is found to be false/fake/incorrect at any stage of verification before or



- after appointment, necessary action will be initiated against the applicant and the candidature shall be cancelled and services shall be terminated forthwith if selected.
- 3. It shall be the responsibility of the candidate to ascertain his/her own eligibility for the post for which he/she is applying in accordance with the prescribed qualifications, experience, etc., and submit his application duly filled-in, along with the desired information and documents as per the advertisement. Suppression of factual information, supply of fake documents, providing false or misleading information or canvassing in any manner on the part of the candidates shall lead to his disqualification. In case, it is detected at any stage of verification before or after appointment, that the candidate was not eligible, his appointment shall be liable to termination forthwith if selected.
- 4. For all teaching posts, the research publications of a candidate shall mean his original contributions/ works which have seen the light of the day after being published by any publishers. The Publications must display the originality of the author with an innovative mind indicating scholarship. Under no circumstances, editing of collected articles/materials which have already been published earlier can be equated with publications as this work does not meet the afore-mentioned objectives and requirements.
- 5. Notwithstanding anything mentioned above, the candidature of the candidate(s) applied against the posts in response to the notification released by the National Sanskrit University or the persons to be appointed against any post as per the notification shall be governed by the Act/Statutes/Ordinances/Regulations/Rules of the University and also the CCS (Conduct) Rules, 1964, CCS (CCA) Rule,1965 or any other rules of the Government of India mutatis mutandis, as amended from time to time and any other rule/resolution prescribed specifically for maintaining the conduct of the employees by the Executive Council of the University.
- 6. The appointment of a candidate shall be subject to verification of character and antecedents by the competent authority. Until the verification of character and antecedents reports are received, the appointment shall be treated as provisional. In case the report/s with regard to his conduct, character, antecedents, etc., is found to be unsatisfactory, the appointment shall be cancelled/terminated forth with.
- 7. <u>Jurisdiction</u>: In case of any disputes, the territorial jurisdiction for adjudication shall be the High Court of Andhra Pradesh only.
- 8. The University reserves the right:
 - (a) to relax any of the requirements with reference to age and experience in exceptional cases and/or in the case of persons already holding comparable positions, on a regular basis, in a University/research institution,
 - (b) to fill up or not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised



- (c) to revise/re-schedule/cancel/suspend the recruitment process without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final and no appeal shall be entertained.
- (d) to reject any application without assigning any reason thereof.
- 9. No queries or correspondence regarding issue of call letters for interview/selection of candidates for the post will be entertained at any stage.
- 10. No enquiry asking for advice as to eligibility will be entertained.
- 11. For posts reserved for SC/ST/OBC/PwBD/EWS candidates, applications from other candidates will not be entertained nor will SC candidates be substituted either by ST/OBC candidates and vice-versa.
- 12. Candidates belonging to OBC category but coming in creamy layer will not be entitled to the benefits of reservation.
- 13. Candidates who have obtained 55% or more marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7-point scale as mentioned below in the Master's Degree should only apply except in the case of SC/ST/OBC and PwBD candidates, for whom the relaxation of 5% is applicable as per Government of India norms and UGC Regulations, 2018.

14. Reservations for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD candidates:

Reservations for SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidates exist as per the Rosters being maintained by the University for various posts in accordance with the guidelines of the UGC/GoI. Candidates applying for the reserved posts should clearly state to which category they belong to.

Candidates of PwBD category:

In case a candidate wants to claim benefits under the Persons with Benchmark Disability category, the candidate's relevant disability should not be less than 40 per cent. Proof to this effect in the form of a valid Disability Certificate must be enclosed to the application, without which the application will be treated as General (Unreserved).

Candidates of OBC category:

The Candidates belonging to OBC, in addition to their community certificate has to submit a declaration to such effect that they don't belong to persons/sections (Creamy Layer) mentioned in column 3 of the schedule mentioned vide O.M.No.36012/22/93-Estt.(SCT) dated 8th September, 1993 and modified DoPT O.M.No.36033/3/2004 Estt. (Res.) dated 09/03/2004, 14/10/2008 and 27/05/2013 without which applications will not be considered.



Candidates of EWS category:

As per the OM No.36039/1/2019-Estt (Res) dated 31.01.2019 of the DoPT, Govt. of India, the benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by a Competent Authority. The Income and Asset Certificate issued by any one of the following authorities in the prescribed format as given in Annexure-I of the above mentioned OM dated 31.01.2019, shall only be accepted as proof of candidate's claim as belonging to EWS: - (i) District Magistrate/Additional District Magistrate/Collector/Deputy Commissioner/Additional Deputy Commissioner/1st Class Stipendiary Magistrate/ Sub- Divisional Magistrate / Taluka Magistrate/Executive Magistrate/ Extra Assistant Commissioner (ii) Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate (iii) Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tahsildar and (iv) Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and/or his family normally resides.

If no copies of the above certificates are uploaded online, it is liable to be rejected for reserved positions and no appeal against its rejection will be entertained.

When a relaxed standard is applied in selecting an SC/ST/OBC/EWS candidate, for example in the age limit, experience, qualification, extended zone of consideration larger than what is provided for un-reserved candidates etc., the SC/ST/OBC/EWS/PwBD candidates shall be counted against reserved vacancies only. Such candidates would be deemed as un-available for the consideration against un-reserved vacancies. However, age relaxation given to PwBD candidates will not be considered as relaxed standard for the above purpose.

Payment of TA: A candidate shall attend the interview/Written Test at the designated place and time at his own expenses. However, the outstation candidates belonging to the SC & ST categories shall be reimbursed to and fro rail fare (sleeper class) for self only by the shortest route. In case any station is not connected by rail, ordinary bus fare shall be paid by the shortest route on production of ticket. The above-mentioned concessions shall not be admissible to those SC/ST candidates who are already in Central/State Government Service/ or holding any other employment under PSUs/Local Governments/Panchayats.

- 16. The candidate shall bring all original Research Papers, Degrees and certificates relating to his age, qualifications, experience, etc. at the time of tests or interview wherever applicable. In case the candidate fails to submit the original documents for verification of the certified photocopies of the enclosures to his application, he may not be allowed to appear at the tests/interview and his candidature may be treated as cancelled without any further communication in this regard
- mu 12211 12000 17. The National Sanskrit University will send call letters (by email alone) to the eligible candidates only for attending interview/test as per rules.

- 18. The age of superannuation is 65 years for teaching staff and 60 years as the case may be for non-teaching staff subject to amendments thereon if any, by the Government of India.
- 19. The candidates who are already in service should upload No Objection Certificate at the time of submission of application online. They shall submit the application through proper channel along with vigilance clearance certificate from the competent authority. However, he may send an advance copy of his application and in case his application is not forwarded due to whatever reasons till the time of written test or interview as the case may be, he/she, should produce a "No Objection Certificate along with the Vigilance Clearance Certificate in a sealed cover" from the employer.
- 20. The application for appointment on deputation shall be forwarded by the employer along with the Annual Performance Appraisal Reports (APARs) for the preceding five years and Vigilance Clearance Certificate, duly certified by the Competent Authority.
- 21. The selections shall be based only on the performance in the interview/test. In pursuance of the Letter No. 19-50/2015-Desk-U, dated 22.12.2015, of the M.H.R.D (Now MoE), there shall be no interview for appointment to the Group 'C' and 'B' posts. Accordingly, no interview shall be held for appointment to the Group 'C' and Group 'B' posts.
- 22. The posts carry usual allowances i.e., Dearness Allowance (DA), House Rent Allowance (HRA) (in case not occupied the quarters), Transport Allowance (TA) etc. as admissible to the Central Government employees and as made applicable to the University by UGC / MOE/ Govt. of India from time to time
- 23. New Pension Scheme in accordance with the O.M. No.F.5-2/97 (DU) dated 26-8-2004 and O.M. No. 1-2/2004 (FA-NPS) dated 15-12-2004 and subsequent amendments thereon received from the University Grants Commission will be applicable for the candidates appointed on or after 1-1-2004.
- 24. For detailed provisions relating to the recruitments in Teaching and Other Academic posts, the candidates are required to go through the UGC Regulations on Minimum Qualifications for Appointment of Teachers and other Academic Staff in Universities and Colleges and Measures for the Maintenance of Standards in Higher Education, 2018 as amended from time to time which are available on the website of the UGC www.ugc.ac.in
- 25. The selected candidate shall produce a medical fitness certificate issued by a Govt. Hospital/or Govt./CGHS empaneled Hospital duly countersigned by the concerned civil surgeon or the Medical Superintendent/Director of the concerned hospital for Group B and C post and certificate from the Medical Board issued by a Govt. Hospital/or Govt./CGHS empaneled Hospital for Group A post as the case may be prior to his joining.
- 26. The terms and conditions of appointment shall be communicated to the candidate in the form of 'Offer of Appointment' to the selected candidates. If the candidate does not accept the terms and conditions mentioned in the offer of appointment within the stipulated time, the offer shall be treated as withdrawn.
- 27. The selected candidates shall be required to perform duties as per the Rules of the University, as amended from time to time. The University shall be free to assign any duty as per the exigency of the situation at any time even during non-working hours/holidays which the employee shall have to perform without fail to avoid any disciplinary action.
