
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

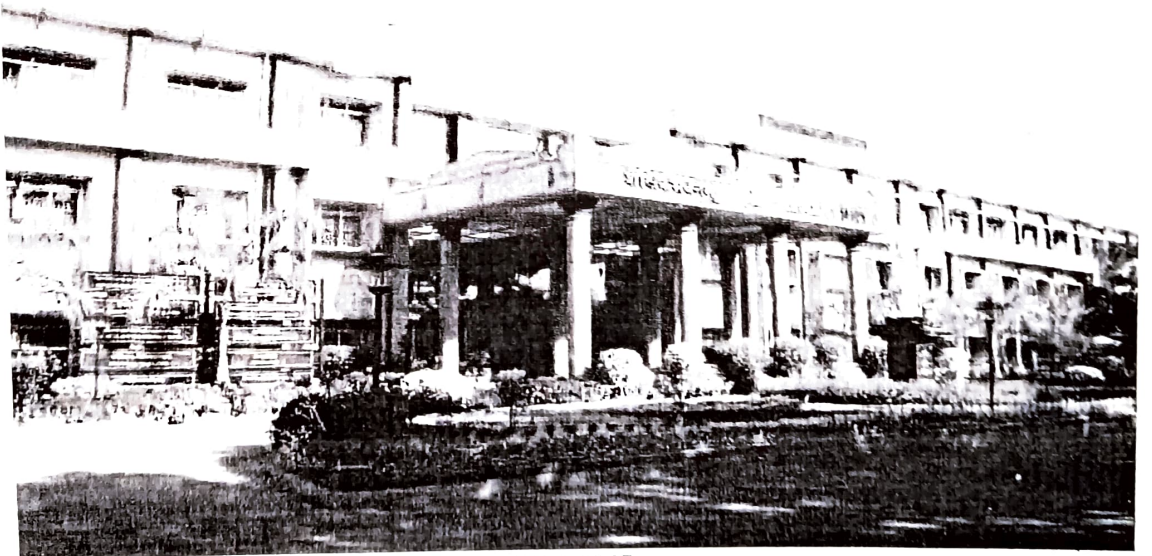

INTRODUCTION

National Sanskrit University, Tirupati, located in the abode of Lord Venkateswara, has been striving hard for the preservation, promotion, and propagation of the Sanskrit language & Shāstras, literature, Indian culture and moral education for more than six decades through various academic and extension activities. The prime objectives of the University are

1. to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional, research and extension facilities for the promotion of the Sanskrit Language and such other branches of learning,
2. to make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences and science in its educational programs to take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter-disciplinary studies and research
3. to educate and train manpower for the overall development, promotion, preservation and research in the field of Sanskrit and Sanskrit traditional subjects.

NSU, earlier known as Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, after being accredited by the NAAC with A+ Grade in the first cycle and an A Grade with 3.71 points in the Second cycle, worked in a renewed and rejuvenated spirit to attain further excellence in various fields of Sanskrit . The institution has experienced phenomenal progress both in terms of quality & quantity. This University has been recognized for its excellence in teaching the Traditional Shāstras along with modern subjects by UGC.

The University has been upgraded from Deemed university status to Central University status in the year 2020 by an Act of Parliament.

The University is popular globally for its multifaceted academic activities owing to which it has been able to receive students from 23 foreign countries including America, Bhutan, Nepal, Myanmar, New Zealand and the United Kingdom.

Further, the following activities in recent years demonstrate the continued development of the university in all fields.

- Implementation of all the suggestions given by the NAAC peer team during its second visit.
- Striving for the Implementation of Academic Bank of Credits(ABC) in all the curricula of the university.

CURRICULAR ASPECTS

Curriculum development at National Sanskrit University is governed by the University Act which provides full autonomy to the various Board of Studies constituted by the University. The programs are regularly upgraded to fulfill the local/national/regional and global developmental needs with learning objectives. All the programs awaken the curiosity in the mind of the learner and train them to think rationally and scientifically and enable him/her to face the unfamiliar. The BOS meets periodically and the designed curriculum of each department is then placed before the Academic Council for approval. University offers traditional and modern programs. All programs opt for Semester system of examination, Elective system in Sastri (UG), Choice based credit system (CBCS) in U.G and P.G, Foundational courses in all specializations, Open and adaptive processes, Interdisciplinary programs etc are offered at various levels.

Academic Flexibility:

U.G, P.G, Shiksha Sastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed), M.Sc. Yoga, P.G Diploma in Yoga Vijnana, Diploma in Vaastu shastra, Translation, Sitar, Dance etc offered by the University train the students to easily cope up with the challenges of the society whilst making them self-reliable and employment-worthy. Programs on modern subjects like B.A, B.Sc, interdisciplinary programs like M.A (Sabdabodha systems & Language technology), MAIMT and M.Sc. (Computer science & Sanskrit language technology) not only provide job prospects in different sectors, but also blend traditional Sanskrit knowledge in their curriculum. The University is chalking its modus operandi for the immediate implementation of various courses in line with NEP -2020 and providing ABC so as to facilitate multiple entry/exit to the learners.

Curricular Enrichment:

At Undergraduate level, there are 229 core courses offered in Sanskrit medium such as Sahitya, Vyakarana, Nyaya, Jyotisha, Vedanta etc. Apart from these, courses in interdisciplinary PG Programs and all courses in Professional PG Programs such as Inclusive Education, Educational Psychology etc are offered in Sanskrit medium. At research level Research Methodology, Ethics, Manuscriptology and Paleography, Sanskrit language skill development etc are taught in Sanskrit. Total number of courses in shastri and Acharya programs which are taught in sanskrit medium - 692.

Feedback system:

Formal and informal feedback systems are in effect at NSU. The feedback is collected from Students, Teachers, Alumni and Parents in a structured format every year. Feedback thus collected is discussed thoroughly and put before various statutory bodies and merits in them are utilized in restructuring the existing curricula.

TEACHING-LEARNING

NSU is a Central Sanskrit University offering a wide range of programmes/courses not just in the traditional Sastras, but also a variety of professional and job-oriented programs to cater to the needs and demands of all its stakeholders. NSU constantly endeavors to improve and strengthen the system and procedures related to Teaching-Learning and Evaluation. NSU encourages the traditional Gurukula method of teaching and has taken various measures to preserve it. Programmes like Prak-shastri (+2), Sammanita Shastri (eq to B.A), Acharya (Eq to M.A) in Sahitya, Vyakarana, Nyaya, Jyotisha etc and modern programmes like M.A (Sabdabodha systems & Language technology), MAIMT and M.Sc. (Computer science & Sanskrit language technology) etc and professional courses like Shiksha Sastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed) and various Diploma, P.G Diploma courses etc ensure that the minds of the learners are ever satiated. Innovative teaching practices are implemented as a continuous learning process through cohesive efforts

of faculty members to ensure Student centric learning, Experiential learning, Participative learning, Learning through Dialogue and problem solving methods. Slow learners are given special care through Remedial Coaching, Counseling through mentors, Peer learning through various language clubs, Group discussions, Student seminars etc. For Advanced Learners Sastrartha prasikshana varga, Shalaka Pariksha, Training for participation in All India Competitions & Talent Festivals, Seminars and Workshops, Peer tutoring, Paarishadam, Extempore Speech, Kavitha Gosthi, Antyakshari, Ashtavadhanam etc are organized for better exposure to Traditional methods of learning, nurturing and advancing the creative skills of the advanced learners. Extension lectures on various topics in Sanskrit and Sastras are organized regularly in the University premises for giving better insight in Sastras to the student community.

In addition to the above, Coaching for Entry into services, Remedial coaching, Coaching for NET/SLET is given for all SC, ST, OBC and minority students. Students are encouraged to showcase their talent in fine-arts under the aegis of Kalaparishad.. Various activities under the auspices of the Physical Education and NSS units like yearly Blood donation Camps, Creating environmental awareness, Clean and Green Campaigns etc instill a sense of service and responsibility to the society amongst the students.

Evaluation Process and Reforms :

All Programs like U.G, P.G, Research programmes are evaluating an ERPS Software system, 100% ICT oriented examination system. CBCS is followed. Declaration of result within stipulated period.

Research Publications and Awards

The NSU has been publishing a research journal namely Mahasvini (Peer-Reviewed Bi-Annual Research Journal) since the academic year 1999. This journal is a peer reviewed journal and is published in two languages viz Sanskrit and English. NSU has published more than 323 books of various Shastra texts, commentaries, ancient Indian heritage and Hidden Science lore in Sanskrit literature and other modern subjects.

University faculty members have been honored with various national and international awards/recognitions such as Presidential awards, Maharshi Badarayan award for young Sanskrit scholars, Sahitya Academy Awards etc. Faculty members are also honored by various NGOs and religious Mathas for their selfless contribution to Sanskrit and Shastras at large.

Extension activities

With a view to create an impact and sensitize students to various social issues and thereby bring about a holistic development in them, NSU organises various Extension activities . like International yoga day, Swachh-Bharat-Abhiyan, NSS Day, Vrushabhotsavam, Swami Jagannatha Ratha Yatra, Blood donation camp, Yugadi celebrations etc.

Many faculty members of the University participate in the live commentaries/lectures/ discussion programs/ on the print and electronic media. They are actively engaged in different programs with a view to make Sanskrit and Shastra learning popular in the nearby areas

Physical Facilities

The University is built on a total area of 42 acres which include various buildings for Academic, Administration and boarding purposes. There are 8 hostels (5 boys hostels 3 Girls hostels) in the University campus.

The institution also has adequate facilities like health centre, bank, ATM, post office, counseling centre and cultural activities centre etc.

Library as learning resource

The University Library is fully automated with KOHA software and supports all latest technologies.. The Central Library has a good collection of rare old books on various subjects like Religion, Philosophy, Vedas, Sanskrit. Apart from the Central Library, every department has a library to serve the needs of the students and faculty alike.

CONCLUSION



MINUTES

1. An online public access catalog (OPAC) is an online database of materials held by a library or group of libraries. Users search a library catalog principally to locate books and other materials available at a library. OPAC login analysis is a criteria for accrediting agencies and also a means of monitoring effective use of library resources by students and researchers. A preliminary enquiry reveals that such a monitoring have some lapses in our University, though the facility is available. The supplier of the software may be asked to implement server settings such that a monthly OPAC Analytics is produced and made available to IQAC. This will be a great way to monitor library usage. IQAC may advice Decision:- Director IQAZC may ensure proper server settings. Technical/human resources required for this may be provided by the Registrar.
2. In response the Registrar resolved his approval
3. The editorial policy, periodicity, technical details, on-line availability etc., of the journals published by various departments is not compiled so far. Such a compilation will pave way to identify lacunae and improve quality. IQAC may approve the data collection.
4. The meeting was concluded with vote thanks by Director IQAC.

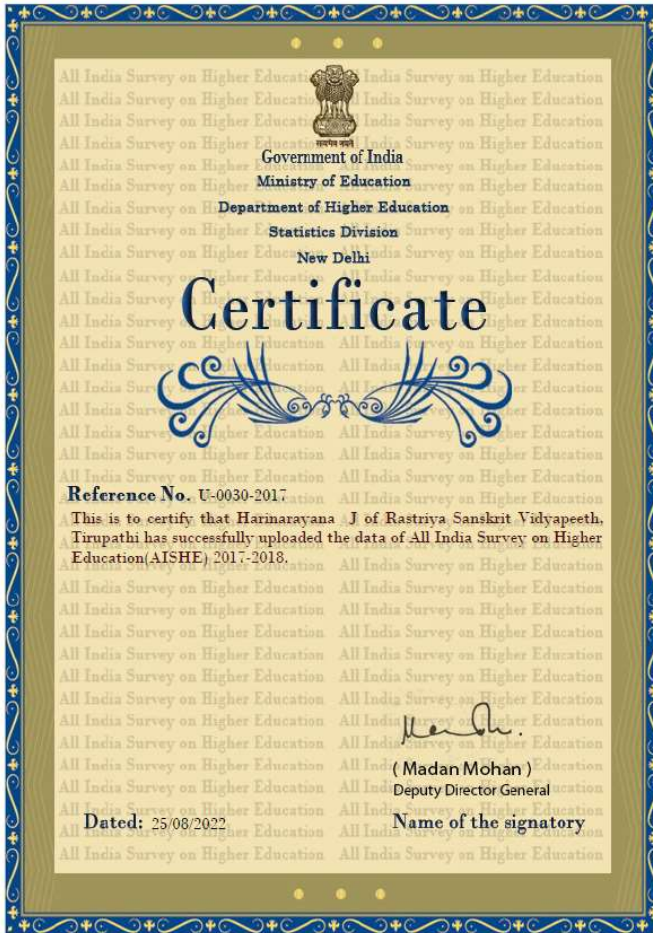


