#### **ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS:**

- i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign university.
- Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR, or a similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET or who are or have been awarded a Ph. D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degree) Regulations, 2009 or 2016 and their amendments from time to time as the case may be exempted from NET/SLET/SET:

Provided, the candidates registered for the Ph.D. programme prior to July 11, 2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institution awarding the degree and such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET/SLET/SET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor or equivalent positions in Universities/Colleges/Institutions subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in a regular mode;
- b) The Ph.D. thesis has been evaluated by at least two external examiners;
- c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- d) The Candidate has published two research papers from his/her Ph.D. work, out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- e) The candidate has presented at least two papers based on his/her Ph. D work in conferences/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC / ICSSR/ CSIR or any similar agency.

The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

Note: NET/SLET/SET shall also not be required for such master's Programmes in disciplines for which NET/SLET/SET is not conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC, like SLET/SET.

B. The Ph. D degree has been obtained from a foreign university/institution with a ranking among top 500 in the World University Ranking (at any time) by any one of the following: (i) Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) (ii) the Times Higher Education (THE) or (iii) the Academic Ranking of World Universities (ARWU) of the Shanghai Jiao Tong University (Shanghai).

### II) EXPERIENCE:

Candidate must have the ability in preparing Self Learning Material and conducting contact classes under CDOE through Sanskrit language in the subjects concerned.

#### HONORARIUM:

Consolidated honorarium of Rs.50,000 /-per month for the assignments pertaining to taking classes, Preparation of self-study material, Proof reading, DTP, etc.

#### **SELECTION PROCESS:**

The selection will be based on marks obtained in written test conducted at PG level and Interview. The weightage of written test and interview will be 50:50.

# SCHEME OF WRITTEN TEST:

Test will be conducted for 100 marks on the following pattern.

(a) Preparation of the Self Study Material in the concerned subjects (SSM) - 50 Marks

(b) Proof reading skills

## GENERAL INFORMATION

1. A relaxation of 5% shall be allowed at the Bachelor's as well as at the Master 's level for the candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Other Backward Classes (OBC) (Noncreamy Layer)/Differently-abled ((a) Blindness and low vision; (b) Deaf and Hard of Hearing; (c) Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid-attack victims and muscular dystrophy; (d) Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness; (e) Multiple disabilities from amongst persons under (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness) for the purpose of eligibility and assessing good academic record for direct recruitment. The eligibility marks of 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever the grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible, based only on the qualifying marks without including any grace mark procedure.

- 2. The selections shall be based only on the performance in the written Test and interview.
- 3. If any claim/certificate/ document is found to be false/fake/incorrect at any stage of verification before or after engagement, necessary action will be initiated against the candidate and the candidature shall be cancelled and engagement shall be terminated forthwith if engaged.
- 4. The University reserves the right
  - a. to fill up or not to fill up any of the vacancies advertised without assigning any reasons.
  - b. to revise/re-schedule/cancel/suspend the recruitment process without assigning any reason. The decision of the University shall be final, and no appeal shall be entertained.
  - c. to reject any application without assigning any reason thereof.
  - d. to relax the eligibility conditions in deserving cases.
- 5. Canvassing will lead to debarring the candidature.
- 6. The applicants are advised to satisfy themselves before attending Walk-in-Interview that they fulfill the eligibility conditions as laid down for the positions in this notification. No enquiry seeking advice as to eligibility etc., will be entertained.
- 7. Caste Certificate issued by Officer who is not below the rank of Mandal Revenue Officer/Tahsildar concerned in respect of SC/ST/OBC candidates shall be submitted at the time of Walk-in Interview for exemption of fee.
- 8. The candidates shall attend the Walk-in-Interview at their own expenses.
- 9. All the candidates are hereby requested to attend one hour before each session. All the candidates should carry their Bio-data, Original Certificates and Caste Certificate (wherever applicable). Further, they are requested to submit a copy of the same at the time of verification.
- 10. The candidates must submit a Demand Draft for Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred only) drawn in favour of The Registrar, National Sanskrit University payable at Tirupati towards application fee at the time of verification. Candidates belonging to SC/ST/PwBD categories and Women candidates are not required to pay any fee while submitting online application.
- 11. The engagement of Guest Faculty is purely temporary.

  - e. The Guest Faculty shall not deny any assignment given by Director, Deputy Director, CDOE and Registrar, as per the requirement.
