1. With the objective to grant appointment on compassionate grounds in accordance with GOI orders on the subject to a dependent family member of the University employee dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds, thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, to relieve the family of the University employee concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency, the University notified the Scheme for Compassionate Appointments. One vacant post of Group C MTS in pay level-01 (Rs.18,000/-- 56,900/-) of the 7th CPC pay matrix has been earmarked filling up under the Scheme for Compassionate Appointments. The interested and eligible candidates may submit the application in Part A of the Scheme for Compassionate Appointments to the Registrar, National Sanskrit University, Tirupati on or before 23.06.2023, with copies of relevant documents.

2. Eligibility:

To a dependent family member of the University employee who —

- a. dies while in service (including death by suicide); or
- b. is retired on medical grounds under Rule 2 of the CCS (Medical Examination) Rules 1957 or the corresponding provision in the Central Civil Service Regulations before attaining the age of 55 years (57 years for erstwhile Group 'D' (is now treated as Group 'C; placing in Pay Level-I of Rs. 18,000-56,900/-) of university employees); or

- c. is retired on medical grounds under Rule 38 of the CCS(Pension) Rules, 1972 or the corresponding provision in the Central Civil Service Regulations before attaining the age of 55 years (57 years for erstwhile Group 'D' (is now treated as Group 'C; placing in Pay Level-I of Rs. 18,000-56,900/-) of university employees);
- d. The family is indigent and deserves immediate assistance for relief from financial destitution; and
- e. Applicant for compassionate appointment should be eligible and suitable for the post in all respects under the provisions of the relevant Recruitment Rules as per the GOI orders issued from time to time.
- 3. Upper Age Limit: 32 years
 - Upper age limit could be relaxed wherever found to be necessary and in accordance with GOI instructions issued from time to time. The lower age limit should, however, in no case be relaxed below 18 years of age.
- 4. All the candidates are advised to go through NSUT Notification dated 13th December, 2022 regarding scheme for Compassionate Appointments for details.
