I am directed to inform that in continuation to this office letter of even number dated 16.03.2023, the competent authority of the CSU is pleased to convey the following Grant-in-Aid under Ashtaadashi Scheme of Ministry of Education, Govt. of India implemented by the Central Sanskrit University, Delhi: -

In this context, it is to be noted that in terms of Ashtaadashi Guidelines, as first instalment 50% of the sanctioned Grants-in-Aid i.e. Rs. 7,50,000/- (seven lakh fifty thousand only) has already been electronically transferred to your Institutional bank Account on 28.03.2023 (copy enclosed). According to the clause No. 13 of Ashtaadashi guidelines, the second instalment of the project i.e. 40% of the sanctioned grants may be considered only after successful completion of the 1st phase of the Project and submission of accounts/expenditure & utilization certificate etc. in the prescribed proforma of Ashtaadashi Form No. -III to VII. Remaining grants may be considered after completion and successful submission of the project.


Further, the details of the target outcome of the project, head wise sanctioned grants and time budget etc. as directed by the competent authority are annexed herewith at annexure no.-I. According to the recommendations & approved guidelines, the grants should be utilized in concerned head and the project shall be completed within time frame. Further in every six months the projects will be reviewed by the expert committee. In addition, CSU has the right to inspect the concerned project at any time without prior intimation. Hence, Project Director/PI should make available the project initiative details (Training programme dates/ Time of the class/ place, venue/ concerned person's name & contact details etc. as applicable to the project) to the CSU.

In addition, the projects/activities conducted with the financial assistance of CSU under the scheme, must be acknowledged by appropriate displaying of name & logo of CSU and also as per revised estimate attached with this letter. A copy of the conditions relating to release of Grant-in-Aid and necessary directions is enclosed herewith at annexure-II. Accordingly, you are requested to ensure that the sanctioned amount should be utilised for said project purpose with strictly following the Ashtaadashi Guidelines.

The Project Director/Principal Investigator is to be directed initiate further necessary steps to start the project works w.e.f. the receipt of this letter, following the guidelines provided to the Institution and also available in the University's website i.e. <https://www.sanskrit.nic.in/schemes/ashtaadashi.php>
