About National Sanskrit University:

The Vidyapeetha was established at Tirupati (A.P) in 1961 by the Government of India on the Recommendations of the Sanskrit Commission (1957) as an autonomous body under the name of Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha Tirupati Society. The basic objective of Vidyapeetha is to impart and improve Sanskrit pedagogy, to accelerate the pace of Sanskrit learning at higher secondary level and to combine the Traditional Sanskrit Education with modern Scientific Research. In the year 1987, the Vidyapeetha was declared as a Deemed to be University by the Government of India as Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha. The Vidyapeetha was elevated as National Sanskrit University (a Central Sanskrit University) established by an act of Parliament in the year 2020. National Sanskrit University, Tirupati is a Premier Institution in the field of Sanskrit Education, and it imparts education only through Sanskrit Medium. The programs in this University are duly recognized by UGC and NCTE. This Institution is a member of Association of Indian Universities (AIU). This Institution was assessed and accredited with 'A' grade (2nd cycle) by NAAC in 2015.

Department of Education

The Department of Education offers Shiksha-Shastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha-Acharya (M.Ed.) and Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D)programmes in Education. The department is in forefront in adopting methodology which is a blend of both ancient texts and techniques with modern strategies.

About the FDP

This programme not only helps the faculty members in augmenting their instructional capabilities in Contemporary Educational Pedagogy but also in their Professional Development with better understanding of professional responsibilities as educators, researchers and administrators as well as in the Organizational development with respect to the requirements and main concerns of an institution.

FDPs are also useful for Career and Personal development of the faculty members which emphasizes upon life planning, interpersonal & communication skills. - vi. to provide an understanding about application of ICT in teaching-learning methods in Education.
- vii. to provide in-depth understanding about Sanskrit teaching pedagogy in Hybrid mode and use of ICT therein.
- viii. to provide guidance on designing effective assessment and evaluation strategies for language teaching.
- ix. to discuss dimensions of School Internship.
- x. to make aware of complex activities in Macro Teaching through Micro Teaching.
- xi. to train participants about the know-how of Micro Teaching skills.
- xii. to provide Hands on experience on pedagogical skills and application of ICT.

iv. Application of ICT for Teacher Educators and Sanskrit Teachers

1. Application of ICT with in preparation of lesson plans.
2. Application of ICT in School administration and in internship program.
3. Application of ICT tools for Teacher Educators and Sanskrit Teachers for classroom teaching.
