- 1961 Institution established in Tirupati by the Govt. of India on the recommendations of the **Sanskrit Commission (1957)** as an Autonomous body under the name of Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati society.
- 1962 Foundation stone of the University was laid on 4th January 1962, by the then Vice-president of India, Dr. S. Radhakrishnan.
- 1971 Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati came under the administrative control of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan as an autonomous body under the ministry of Education, Govt. of. India in April 1971
- 1987 The institution was declared as a Deemed University by the Government of India, under the name of Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha
- 2020 The University is rewarded as National Sanskrit University, A
 Central University by the Govt. of India under Parliamentary act in the
 month of March, 2020


