3. The answer scripts of the candidates for Paper-II (Descriptive Test) shall be evaluated only in respect of those candidates who secure the minimum qualifying marks in Paper-I (Objective Test). The candidates who secure the minimum qualifying marks in Paper-II shall be called for the Skill Test.

4. The merit list of the candidates shall be drawn based on the total marks obtained in Paper-I (Objective Test) and Paper-II (Descriptive Test) subject to qualifying the Skill Test. In case of bunching / bracketing of candidates in the results of the written test, the merit list would be decided as follows:

(a) Secured Highest Marks in Paper-I

(b) Senior in Age

(c) Higher Academic Qualification (s)


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(d) As decided by the Appointing Authority in consideration of Service Experience of the Candidates, etc.

(a) The question paper would be bilingual (English and Hindi)

(b) The hall tickets (call letters) are to be downloaded by the eligible candidates from the Recruitment Portal, when they are made available and an intimation regarding the same shall be sent to their e-mail IDs through Samarth Portal.


