1. NATIONAL SANSKRIT UNIVERSITY : BRIEF

The erstwhile Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha was established at Tirupati (A.P) in 1961 by the Government of India on the recommendations of the Central Sanskrit Commission (1957) as an autonomous body under the name of Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha Tirupati Society. The basic objective of setting up the Vidyapeetha is to impart and improve Sanskrit pedagogy, to accelerate the pace of higher Sanskrit learning and to combine the traditional Sanskrit education with modern Scientific Research. Later, Kendriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha, Tirupati came under the administrative control of Rashtriya Sanskrit Sansthan as an autonomous body under the Ministry of Education in April 1971. In the year 1987, the Vidyapeetha was declared Deemed to be University by the Government of India by name Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha.

Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeetha has been elevated as National Sanskrit University (a central University established by an act of Parliament) in the year 2020. National Sanskrit University, Tirupati is a Premier Institution in the field of Sanskrit education and it imparts education only through Sanskrit Medium. Teaching facilities are available for the study of following programs in regular mode viz., Prak-sastri, Shastri, B.A. (Hons.), B.Sc (Computers), B.Sc in Yoga, Acharya in 19 Sastras, M.A. in Hindi, M.A. in Sanskrit. (Sabdabodha), M.Sc. in Computer Sci. & Sanskrit Language Technology, M.Sc. in Yoga Therapy, MAIMT, Shiksha Shastri (B.Ed.), Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.), Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) & Part time programmes etc. The programs of this organization are duly recognized by UGC and NCTE.

2. **ABOUT VIDYAVARIDHI (PH.D) PROGRAMME**

This degree in Research offered by National Sanskrit University, Tirupati is known as Vidyavaridhi. The Programme is offered in various branches of Traditional Shastras & Education, subject to availability of vacancies. The Programme is offered as per

- 1) The University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D. Degrees) Regulations, 2022 as amended from time to time;
- 2) National Sanskrit University, Tirupati, Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) Regulations 2022
- 3) The extant policy decisions of the Statutory Bodies of the University.

3. **DURATION OF THE VIDYAVARIDHI (PH.D) PROGRAMME**

The duration of the Vidyavaridhi degree shall be for a minimum duration of three years including Coursework and for a maximum duration of six years with permissible extension of time as per the above Regulations.

The candidate admitted into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Programme has to undergo six months compulsory Vidyavaridhi Coursework on a full-time basis followed by a written test. After the Successful completion of 6 months course work, the research scholar will be allotted a research supervisor for pursuing Research work in concerned Topic / Shastra under his / her guidance.

This degree in research is known as Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D). The title of the Degree will be printed in Sanskrit along with English Translation, will be awarded after completion of the programme.

4. **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

The medium of instruction for the course work examination is Sanskrit and the Vidyavaridhi Thesis should be written in Sanskrit language only.

5. **ABOUT VIDYAVARIDHI (PH.D) ENTRANCE TEST (VVET 2023)**

The Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Entrance Test (VVET 2023) is conducted for the A.Y. 2023-24, is meant for Admission into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) programme of National Sanskrit University Tirupati only. Qualifying the Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Entrance Test (VVET-2023) is a prerequisite for admission into the programme.

The following are the details of information to be noted by the candidates before filling-up of the prescribed application form:

- (i) Admission into Vidyavaridhi Programme will be through written entrance test Called Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test (VVET 2023).
- (ii) The candidates seeking admission to the programme must apply in the prescribed format.
- (iii) The following categories of candidates shall be exempted from appearing the Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Entrance Test in Traditional Shastras & Education-(VVET- 2023):
 - (a) Candidates who qualified in UGC-CSIR JRF / NET / SLET
 - (b) Visistacharya (M.Phil) in Sanskrit scholars.
 Such candidates are also required to submit their application & enroll themselves for the programme along with all other candidates.
- (iv) Those JRF candidates who wish to apply under Non-JRF vacancy should apply separately. One single application for JRF & Non-JRF vacancies will not be counted and this may lead to cancellation of application form.
- (v) The JRF/NET qualified candidates with Code 25 are eligible for Sahitya, Puranetihasa, Dharmasastra & Research and Publications. The candidates if interested to apply for more than one subject, should apply separately for all the selected subject(s).
- (vi) The JRF/NET qualified candidates with Code 73 are eligible for concerned shastra in which qualified JRF/NET and for Research and Publications only. The candidates if interested to apply for more than one subject should apply separately for both the subjects.

7. COMPETENT AUTHORITIES FOR ISSUING THE CERTIFICATES FOR RESERVED CATEGORIES

Candidate who belongs to any of the above reserved categories should bring a certificate of their category duly attested by a Gazette Officer at the time of admission in University, failing which the eligibility will be rejected.

- (a) **Candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/EWS :** District Magistrate/Sub-Divisional Magistrate/Tahsildar/MRO/Competent Authority. Candidates belonging to the OBC/EWS (Non-creamy Layer) shall submit the latest certificate (not more than 1 year old) issued by the competent authority.
- (b) **Candidates belong to PwD and Visually Challenged:** Chief Medical Officer of Civil Hospital (40% or more disability will only be considered).

10. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO THE PH.D. PROGRAMME**

The following are the eligibility conditions as per clause 3(1) & (2) the UGC Regulations 2022 and the NSU regulations to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme:

- (1) Candidates who have **completed**:
 - (i) A 1-year/2-semester master's degree/Acharya/M.A.(Sanskrit)/ Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed. in Sanskrit) in the relevant subject program after a 4-year/8-semester bachelor's degree programme (or)
A 2-year/4-semester master's degree/Acharya/M.A.(Sanskrit)/ Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed. in Sanskrit) programme after a 3-year/6-semester bachelor's degree programme or qualifications declared equivalent to the master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed (or)
Any equivalent post-graduate degree/title recognized by the National Sanskrit University, Tirupati. (or)
equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of the educational institution.
 - (ii) Provided that a candidate seeking admission after a 4-year/ 8-semester bachelor's degree programme should have a minimum of 75% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade on a point scale wherever the grading system is followed.
 - (iii) Those eligible candidates who have passed JRF/NET/SLET/ SET/ UGC Fellowship Awardees/Visistacharya (M.Phil) in the concerned Shastra and Education are exempted from the Vidyavaridhi Entrance Test. But they must apply in the prescribed format by paying the prescribed fee.
 - (iv) Those who qualify UGC JRF/NET in **25 CODE** are eligible to get admission only in Sahitya, Puranetihasa, and Dharmashastra and in Research & Publications without entrance test and subject to the fulfilling of all other eligibility criteria as per the regulations and the outcome of interview performance and over-all Rank. (AND)
 - (v) Those who qualify UGC JRF/NET in **73 CODE** are eligible to get admission only in that particular Shastra/Research & Publications, subject to the fulfilling of all other eligibility criteria as per the regulations and the outcome of interview performance and over-all Rank.

Further, the JRF/NET qualified candidates in **73 CODE (Traditional Sastras)/Education (09) Code** should have possessed 16 credits/obtained equivalent marks in each semester or should have possessed 32 credits/obtained equivalent marks per year in annual pattern in that particular Shastra/Education/Research & Publications in which the candidate has applied for the Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Admission.

- (2) A relaxation of 5% marks or its equivalent grade may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer)/ Differently-abled, Economically Weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.
- (3) Foreign candidates who have passed Acharya/M.A. [Sanskrit/equivalent degree (Sanskrit)]/Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed in Sanskrit) with 55% marks in the aggregate from any University outside India along with PG Degree in Education with 55% of marks can also apply for the VVET 2023-24 through the Ministry of External Affairs & Ministry of Education, Govt. of India.

Foreign Nationals including NRIs must produce a valid Research Visa at the time of seeking admission into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) programme. The Foreign/ NRI scholars should also go through all the process of admission procedure from submission of application for entrance test and to follow admission procedure.

- (4) Candidates who have completed the M.Phil. programme with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed or equivalent qualification from a foreign educational institution (accredited by an assessment and accreditation agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country to assess, accredit or assure quality and standards of educational institutions), equivalent to M.Phil Degree in the concerned shastra of an Indian Institution, shall be eligible for admission to the Ph.D. programme.

11. **MODE OF ENTRANCE EXAMINATION**

Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Entrance Test (VVET-2023) shall be conducted at National Sanskrit University through **OFF-LINE MODE** only.

12. **PROCESS OF APPLYING FOR VVET-2023**

Step by step process for applying for Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) entrance test (VVET-2023) for admission.

17. QUALIFYING MARKS IN THE ENTRANCE TEST

- Candidates who have secured 50% marks in the entrance test to become eligible for the interview.
- A relaxation of 5% marks (from 50% to 45%) will be allowed in the entrance examination for the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/ Differently-abled category/ Economically weaker Section (EWS) and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time.

[Note: Mere qualification in the Entrance Test, should not be claimed as a right for getting seat by the candidate. Seats will be given on merit basis as per the regulations of National Sanskrit University, Tirupati.

18. METHOD OF SELECTION

The candidates who have qualified in the entrance test will be called for the interview. University shall decide the number of eligible students to be called for an interview based on the number of Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D.) seats available.

Seats will be given on the merit basis as per the Regulations of the UGC / National Sanskrit University, Tirupati.

The selection of candidates based on the Vidyavaridhi Entrance test (VVET) conducted by the University, a weightage of 70 % for the entrance test and 30% for the performance in the Department interview/viva- voce shall be given.

And, for the candidates based on the exemption from writing the Entrance test due to possession of JRF/NET/M.Phil/National Fellowship by the UGC or any other equivalent, a weightage of 70% on Acharya/PG marks and 30% for the performance in the interview/viva-voce shall be given. Since the JRF/NET/M.Phil or any other equivalent qualified candidates, get the exemption from writing the entrance exam, *No Additional Marks will be added* for possessing the JRF/ NET/ M.Phil/National Fellowship or any other equivalent from the UGC in the Non-JRF admission interview.

National Fellowship for SC/ST/OBC/PWD/SJSGC or any other equivalent fellowship awardees by the UGC will not be admitted under JRF Admission Notification.

19. VIDYAVARIDHI PROGRAM FEE

Post admission process, Semester/year wise programme fee as decided by the University from time to time is to be paid.

20. HOSTEL AND MESS FEE

Hostel and Mess facility will be provided after admission, subject to availability. Apart from the program admission fee, hostel and mess fees are to be separately borne by the Research scholars.

21. INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLING THE VEET-2023 EXAM APPLICATION

- (a) Read guidelines carefully before filling up of the application;
- (b) These guidelines contain important information related to the Entrance test.
- (c) Candidates who would like to appear for the Entrance Test should apply online via the link provided or the link available at the University Website “nsktu.ac.in”.
- (d) The facts mentioned via ONLINE submission of application will be duly verified at the time of examination and admission.
- (e) On verification of any type of false information the candidature will be forfeited. It also includes disqualification from examination or cancellation of admission.
- (f) Clear and latest photograph may be pasted on the application form and Hall-tickets.
- (g) Candidate has to retain his/her mobile number given in the application till the completion of the admission process.
- (h) Eligible candidates should only apply for the Entrance test. If the candidate lacking the prescribed qualification appears for VVET-2023, he/she only will be responsible for the consequences.
- (i) The admission will be strictly on the basis of number of seats available and rank in the concerned subject i.e. merit list.
- (j) Scrutinizing of eligibility for admission, verification of reservations etc., are under the control of National Sanskrit University, Tirupati as per the UGC norms.
- (k) The decision of the Vice-Chancellor of the National Sanskrit University, Tirupati will be final regarding admission.
- (l) At the time of entering the examination hall, admit card and ID card (Aadhar/Vote ID/Driving License) has to be produced compulsorily.
- (m) All judicial matters will be settled under Amaravati (Andhra Pradesh) High Court Jurisdiction only.

22. INSTRUCTIONS FOR ATTENDING VVET-2023 ENTRANCE TEST

- (i) At the time of entering the examination hall, admit card has to be produced compulsorily.
- (ii) Candidates using unfair means, getting external help or helping others or indulging in indiscipline in the test will be disqualified. Criminal or judicial action can also be initiated.

- (iii) In case of mismatch of photo with self, or any other doubts etc., suspension from exam or legal action will be taken. For any such inconvenience, the candidate himself/herself will be responsible for this.
- (iv) Calculator, mobile phone, smart watch etc., are prohibited in the examination hall.
- (v) All the candidates are informed to strictly follow the COVID-19 instructions compulsorily.

23. SOME IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS

- (a) Only Acharya/PG/Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) in Sanskrit completed candidates are informed to apply for the Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Entrance exam (VVET-2023). Acharya/PG/Shiksha Acharya (M.Ed.) in Sanskrit pursuing candidates or final semester examination appeared candidates or final semester results awaited candidates NEED NOT APPLY.
- (b) Only eligible candidates in VVET-2023 will be admitted in order of merit and GOI rule of reservation.
- (c) At the time of admission at National Sanskrit University, Tirupati into Vidyavaridhi (Ph.D) Programme, the VVET-2023 original admit card has to be submitted compulsorily.
